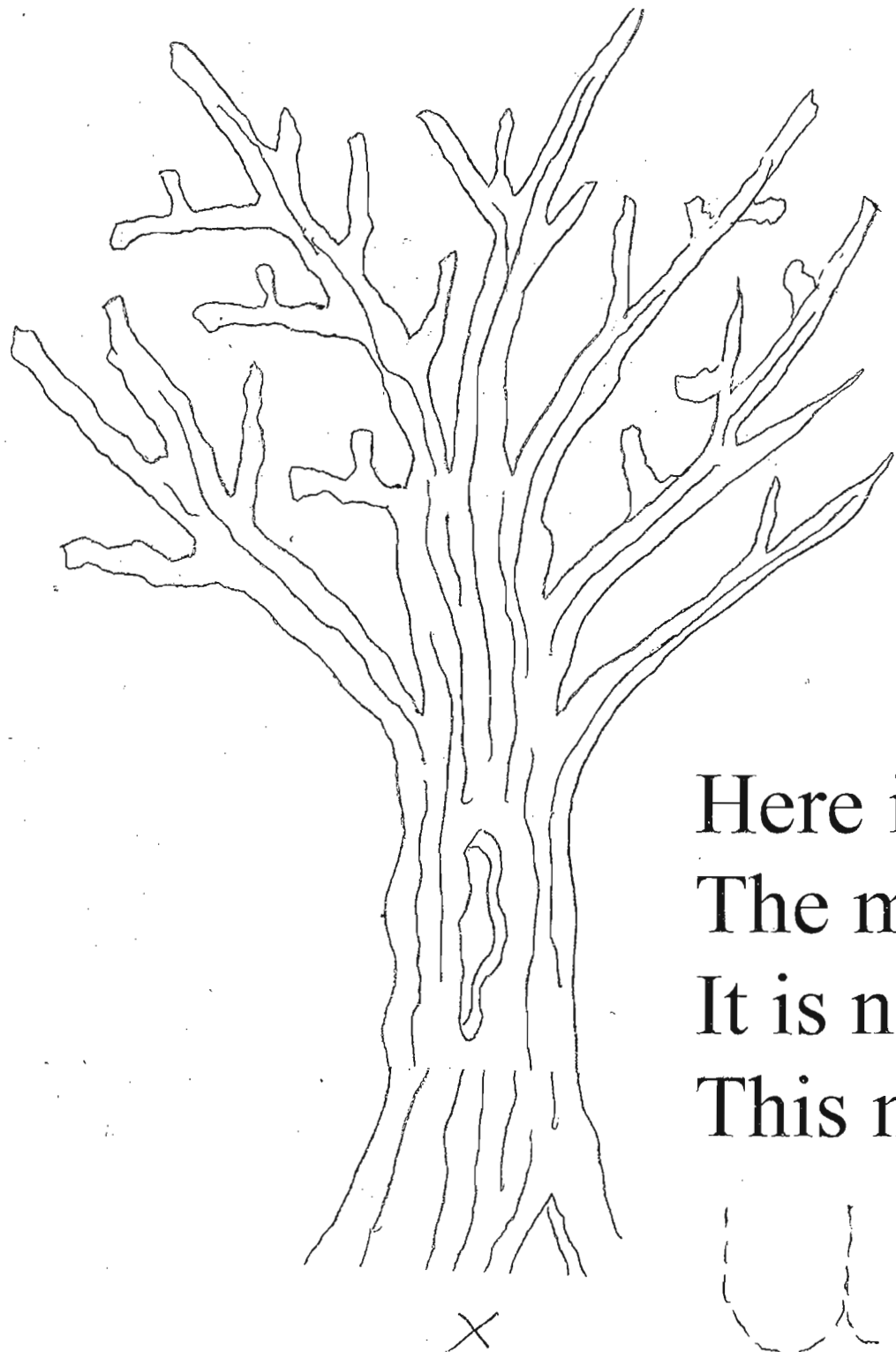
This is my mitten.

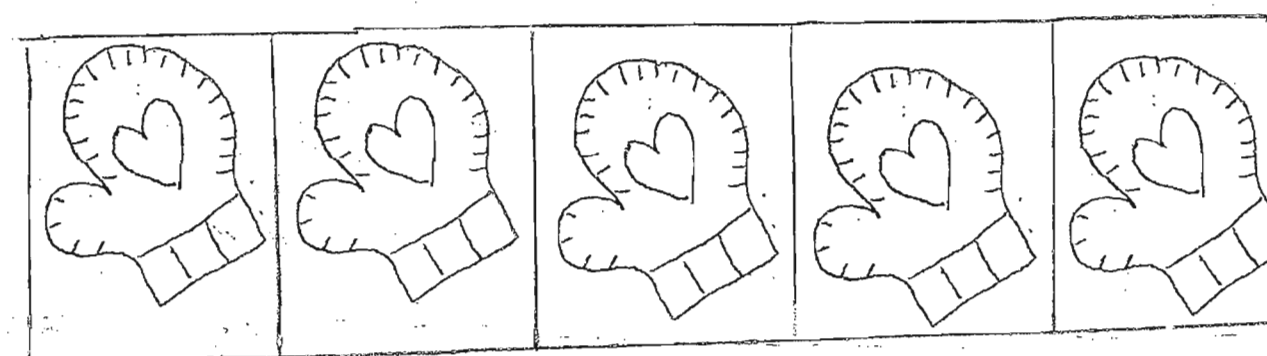
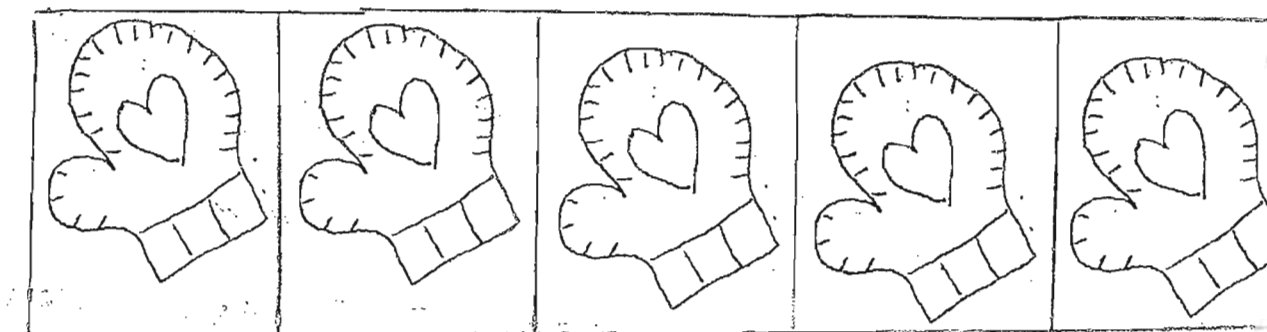
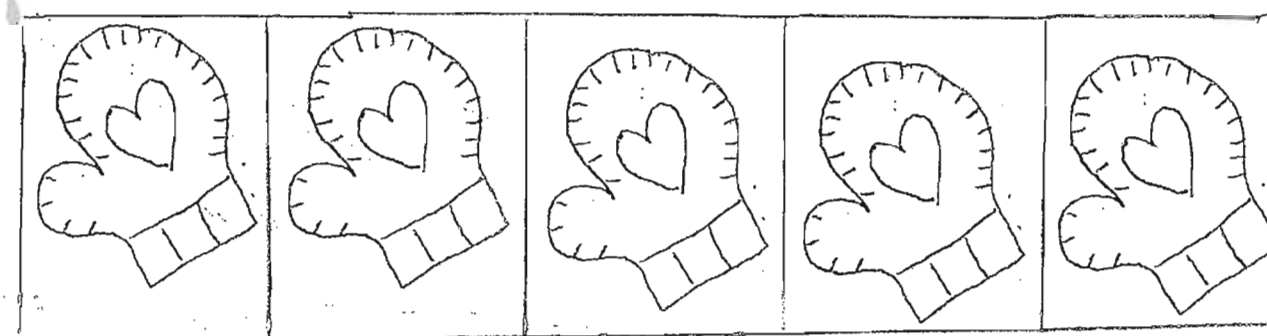
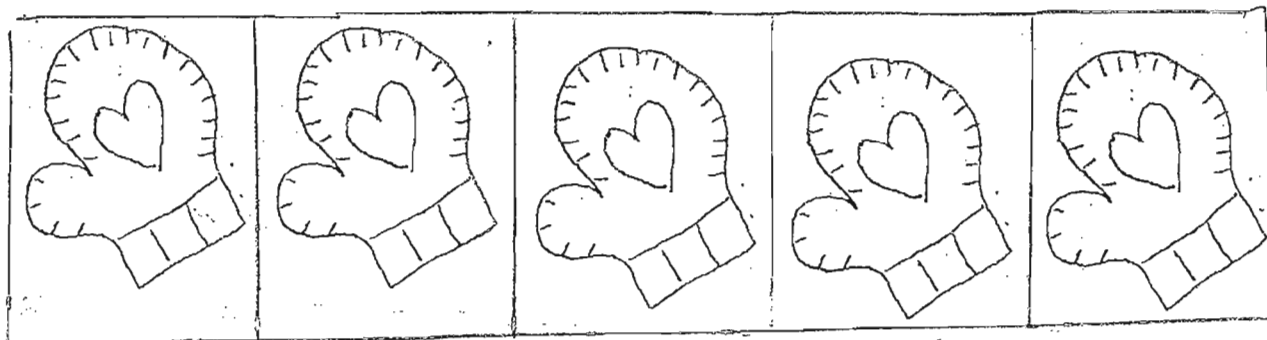
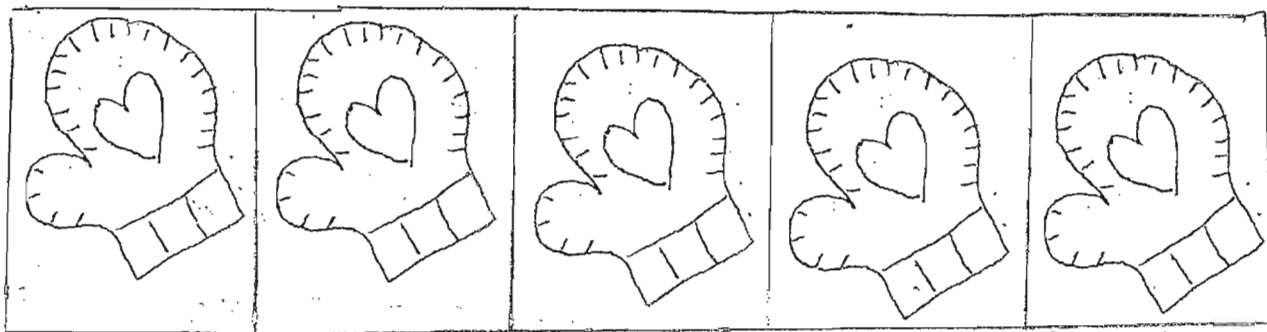
It is not mine.
