

- Penguins are birds.
- They cannot fly.
- They have waterproof feathers.
- There are 17 different kinds of penguins.
- The smallest is the Fairy, and the largest is the Emperor penguin.
- They live in the Southern Hemisphere.
- Penguins swim in the ocean using their webbed feet as rudders.
- Penguins cannot swim backwards.
- They look like torpedoes.
- They spend half of their life in the water.
- They can swim very fast, up to 20 mph!
- They eat mostly fish swallowing them whole.
- Their bills have a little hook at the end so they can grab the fish.
- Their tongue has bristles on it to hold the slippery seafood so it doesn't get away.
- The penguins are black and white.
- Scientists call this counter-shaded.
- The dark back helps the penguin blend in with the ocean when the penguin is seen by his predators from the sky. His white belly keeps him camouflaged with the lighter surface when he is viewed by his predators from below.
- Penguins lay 1 or 2 eggs and stay with their mate for as long as they have chicks together.
- Penguins live 15 to 20 years.



