


Count With Me Ornament Book

Materials:

- Assorted colors of construction paper for ornaments.
- Masters
- Scissors
- Glue sticks
- Aluminum foil: You need foil for the top of the ornament, as well as the cover of the number book. (Cut rectangles for cover so children glue the extra square from the master, on both sides, fold over, and cut around edges. You could have these pre-done.)
- Crayons or Optional: glitter glue or puffy paint to write name.

Directions:

1. Run off masters
2. Children cut out their ornament.
3. You can write their name on with glitter glue or puffy paint for extra pizzazz. While they're drying children...
4. Cut out their number pages and sequence them.
5. Staple booklet together so that it flips up.
6. Children glue aluminum foil to the top of their ornament and fold the edges over.
7. Children glue aluminum foil to their cover.
8. Staple booklet to top so that it flips up.
9. When everyone is finished we sit on our *Circle of Friends* carpet and read our book together in English and Spanish, then we "blast off" from 10-0 and put our booklets in our backpacks.
10. I've given you a variety of numbered pages to fit the skills you are working on + a TRACE the numbers page, and a blank page to fill in larger numbers or equations.
11. I've also given you the option to make this an **ABC With Me** instead of a Counting Book. You can TRACE the letters or use regular ones. As a bonus I've included SHAPES in the empty boxes. Enjoy! 😊
