Run off on white paper.  
Cut out so that you have an edge to  
put glue on.  
Glue this "door" verse to the back of  
the castle so that you can read it  
when children open the outside  
castle door.

Turrets. Run off on gray construction paper.  
cut out. Roll into the shape <sup>size</sup> of a toilet paper



roll.  
Staple  
top & Bottom  
Staple to  
the flat  
Castle on  
either  
side.








Run off on yellow construction paper and cut out.  
You do not have to cut each individual peak, just straight across.  
Staple a strip of card stock, or bulletin board boarder to the bottom.  
This will be wrapped around a child's head and stapled so that it fits.  
Staple so that the picky points are in front and not touching a child's forehead or catching in their hair.  
Children decorate with flat-backed rhinestones and glitter or glitter glue.


# Shield

or Cardstock.  
Cover with aluminum  
foil

② Glue cross  
Glue  $\nabla$  w  
verse to center.  
Punch holes:  
Insert pipe cleaner - Make  
a circle "hand hold."

Make template.  
Trace crosses on  
a variety of  
colors of construction  
paper.





Children cut out crosses.

variety of colors.



has aluminum foil on it.


