








Quilt Glyph

Read the glyph sentences. Students color their quilt shapes the appropriate colors. Mount their glyph on a sheet of pre-cut construction paper. Students add their name and a photo. Arrange the glyphs to look like one big quilt.



1. Color the circle your favorite color.
2. Color the square your least favorite color.
3. Color the triangle your favorite FLAVOR. i.e. cherry would be red, lemon would be yellow etc.
4. If you have a sister color the heart pink. If you don't have a sister leave it white.
5. If you have a brother color the octagon red. If you don't have brother leave it white.
6. Color the pentagon orange if you were born in the fall, green if you were born in the summer, purple if you were born in the spring, and leave it white if you were born in the winter.
7. Color the rectangle brown if you have a pet.
8. Color the star yellow if you are excited about being in school.
9. Color the hexagon blue if your favorite season is summer, color it brown if your favorite season is fall, color it pink if your favorite season is spring, color it gray if your favorite season is winter.
10. Color the oval pink if your favorite subject is reading, green if it's math, orange if it's writing, blue if it's something else.
11. Write your name in the center.
