Finally, I'd like to take a cruise to Alaska. I think it would be exciting to see a glacier up close and personal, as well as go whale watching.

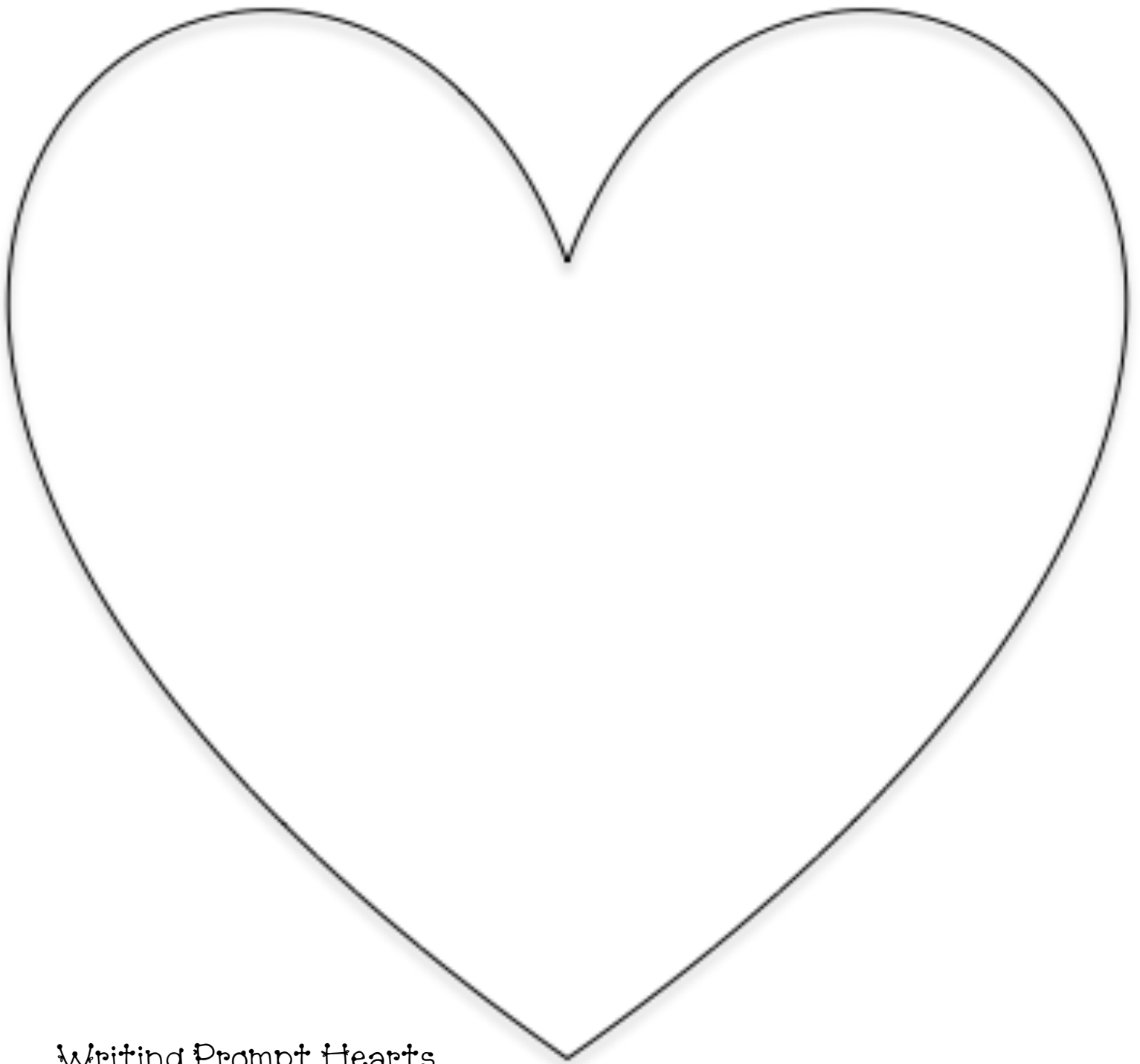

Remind them to not just make a list, but describe (using some adjectives) and explain why.




Books I Love To Read
