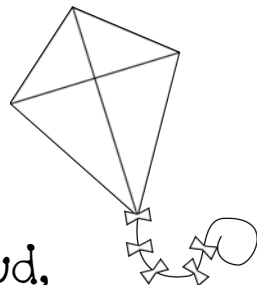
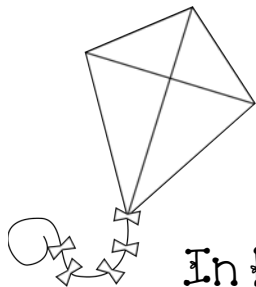
In January, we read about snowmen, snow and flakes.

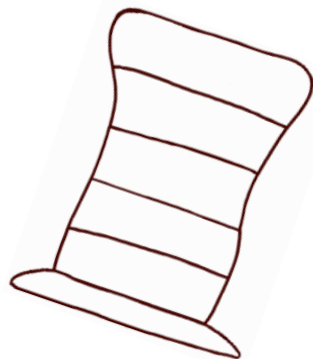

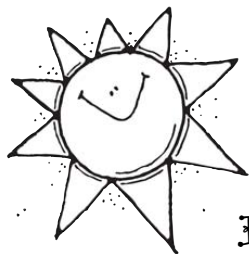

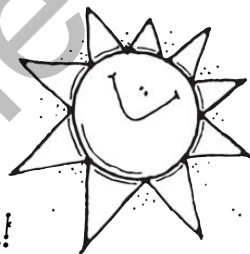

kindergarten, first & second and tweaked the verse to fit.



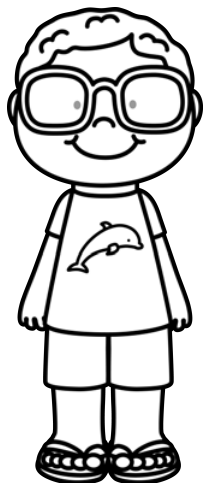
