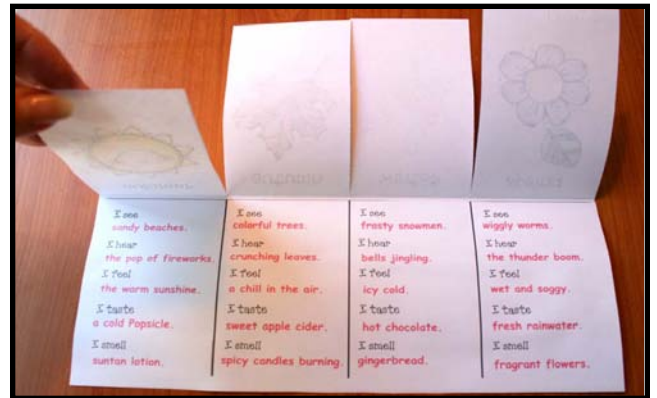
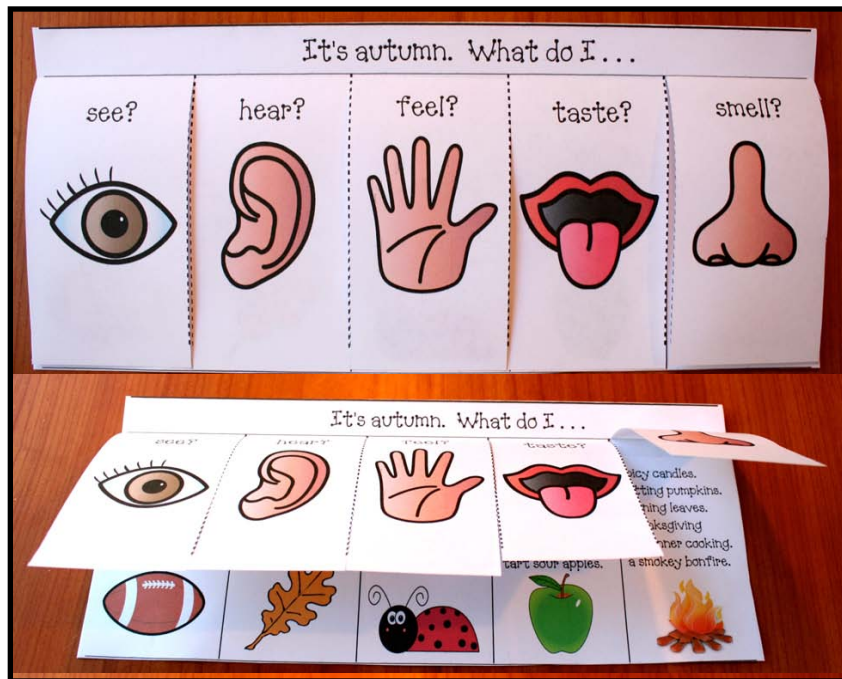

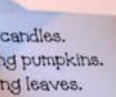

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Here is my completed sample, so you can easily make an example to share with your kiddos.

Decide how many things you want your students to list under the flaps.

I suggest one for PK kiddos, 2-3 for K-1, and 3-5 for 2nd & above.

Encourage older students to use descriptive adjectives.

Add to the pizzazz of the activity, by having children draw a picture of the last thing that they "sensed".

They may want to jot their list on a sheet of scratch paper, making sure that they put the item that they want to draw last.

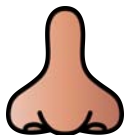

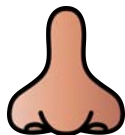

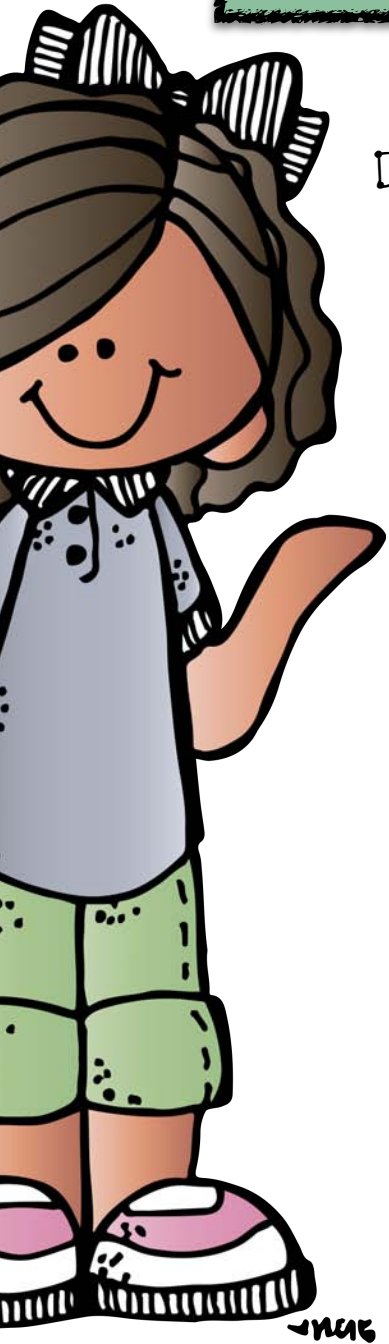
