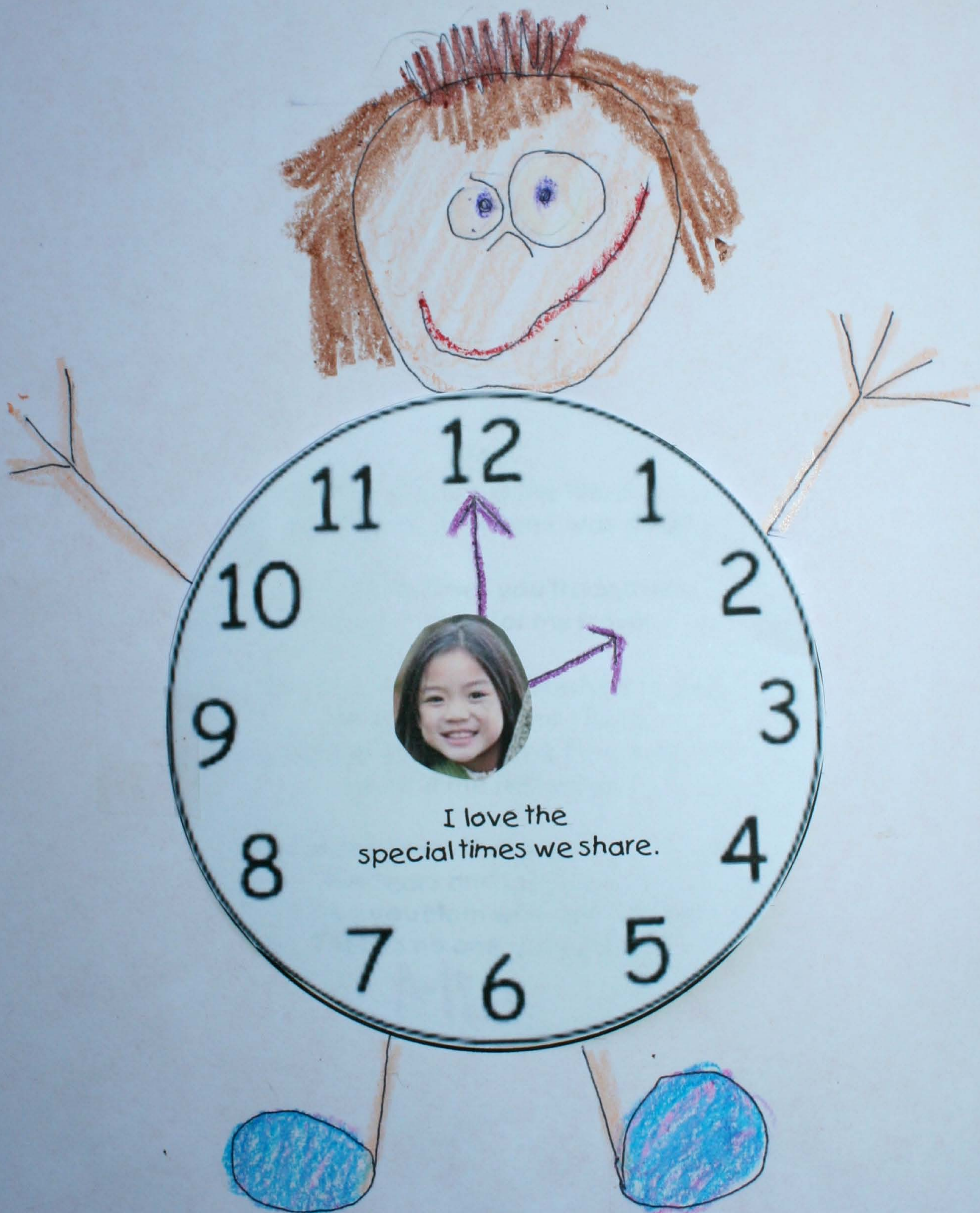

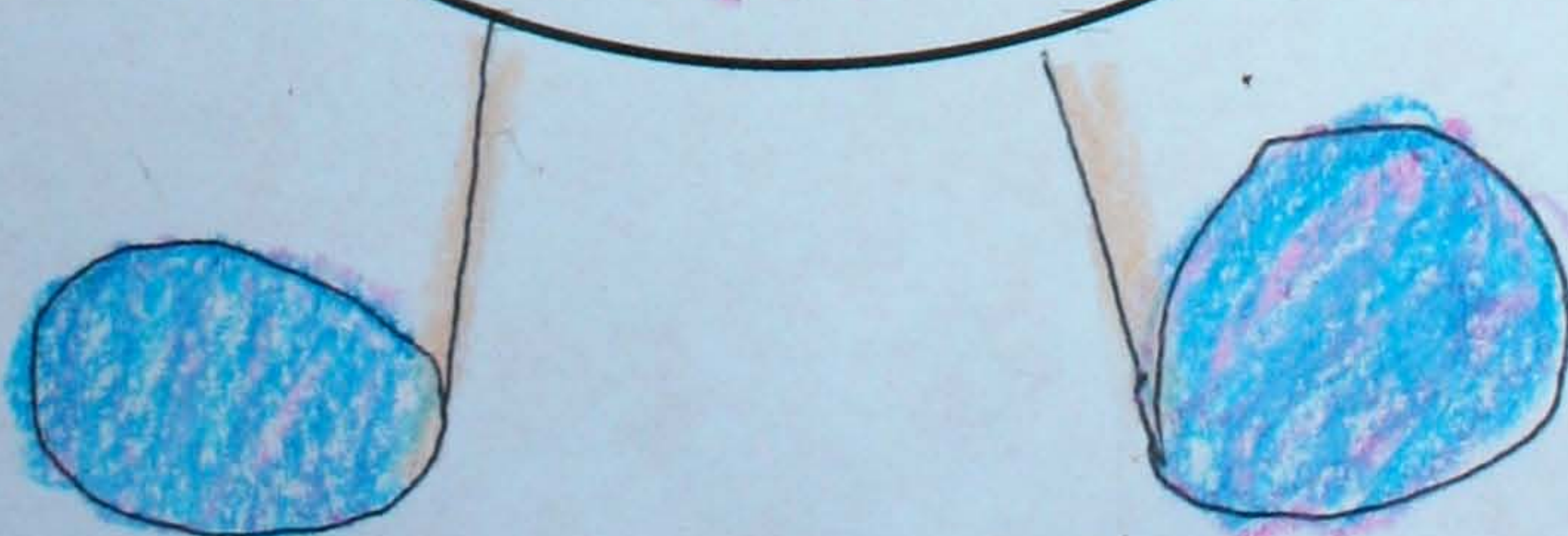
I love you for all the times you
picked me up when I was down.

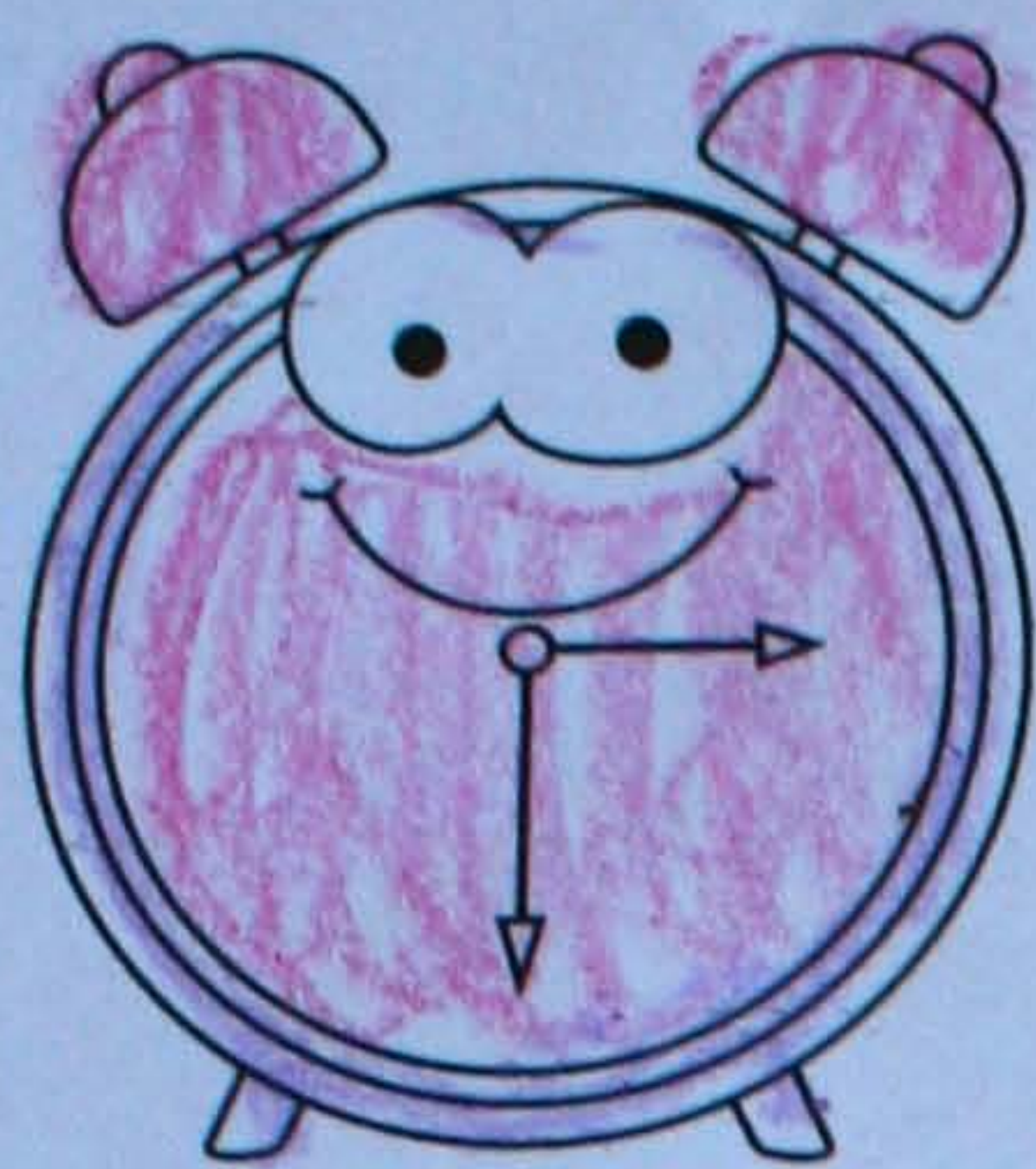
For all the times you traded your
