



FYI 6-Piece Puzzles

I designed these 6-piece puzzles for my kiddos because putting a puzzle together is one of our standards.

Students can simply color, cut and put their puzzle together, or they can pick a partner and take turns rolling a dice.

Whatever number they roll, they place that numbered piece on the matching numbered square on their puzzle grid.

The first one to complete their puzzle is the winner.




My students absolutely love playing these puzzle games.

These puzzles provide a quick, easy, and educationally fun activity for that last crazy day before break, and can be used as a sweet Thanksgiving card for parents too.



To extend the activity, have students glue their pieces to the puzzle grid as they play the game, then when done, write about the things that they are thankful for, or a note to parents of why they are thankful for them on the back of their completed puzzle.
