Spatial
Directions

- Place your penguin ABOVE the egg.
- Place your penguin UPON the egg.
- Place your penguin BEHIND the egg.
- Place your penguin ON the egg.
- Place your penguin INSIDE the pocket of the egg.
- Place your penguin BETWEEN the egg and the LID.
- Place your penguin OVER the egg.
- Place your penguin BELOW the egg.
- Place your penguin AGAINST the egg.
- Place your penguin IN the hole.
- Place your penguin ON the egg.
- Place your penguin ON the egg.





Since spatial directions are part of the 2D shape standards, I designed "Where's The Penguin?" a whole-group assessment game.

- Students choose a boy or girl penguin, which they color & cut. They also Cut & glue their egg pocket together.
- Teacher calls out a spatial direction such as "The penguin is above, below, under, beside, on the left/right, behind, inside, on over... the egg."
- Students place their penguin in that position.
- You can see at a glance who is having difficulty & jot yourself a note.
- Later, pair up struggling students with a partner for more practice.
- Children store their penguin inside the egg pocket, so you can play another day.
- This is fun for them & quick & easy-peasy for you.
- Encourage students to continue to play the game when they take it home.
