Run the hearts off on 3 different colors, so that it's more noticeable that they are unique.
Students write on each heart how they will love the earth by reducing, reusing and recycling.
One heart is for things they will do to reduce, the other for recycle etc.
Add a bit of pizzazz by having them glue their school photo to one of the hearts.
Run off the recycle sign on 3 different shades of green if available.
Students trim and then fold their heart and symbol pieces in $\frac{1}{2}$.
Demonstrate how this is done, by making a dangler in front of your students.
Glue the pieces together so that they are in a tri-fold.
Punch holes at the top and bottom, and attach the hearts to the symbol; or simply slip
a long piece of yarn through both pieces to connect them.
Make a yarn loop at the top to hang from the ceiling.
