



Mother's Day Sign Language Card

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Materials:

- 2 different shades of construction paper (I like to use light pink and hot pink.)
- Glue sticks
- Scissors
- Crayons
- Ink pen
- Stapler
- ***Optional:*** School photo
- ***Optional:*** yarn or ribbon & a hole punch


Prep:













- Run off masters.
- Cut into strips. Make sure you tell your students not to cut out the letters, just to glue the entire strip to their paper.
- I model everything I do and then display my sample.
- Cut a little bit bigger construction paper strip for the two-part card.


The next day...

1. Students glue "I" strip to the front of their construction paper rectangle.
2. Using crayons, children COLOR the heart whatever color they decide. They also COLOR the hands.
3. Students GLUE their photo to the middle of the heart if you are opting to do that step.
4. Children GLUE the "M" strip to the second color construction paper.
5. Students WRITE their name on the bottom of the inside card using an ink pen.
6. Teacher helps them staple the top of their card.
7. If you'd like you can punch a hole in the corner and tie with a ribbon or yarn bow.

- Teach your students to sign, *"I love you mom!"*
- Here is the sign for "I".
- Then have them put their arms criss-cross over their chest for "love".
- Next have them point their index finger at their mom for "you".
- Then have them finger spell M-O-M. (See hand letters below.)
- Follow it up by having them give their mom a big hug!
- If you'd like them to give her a card with the hand signs I've also included a pattern for that.
