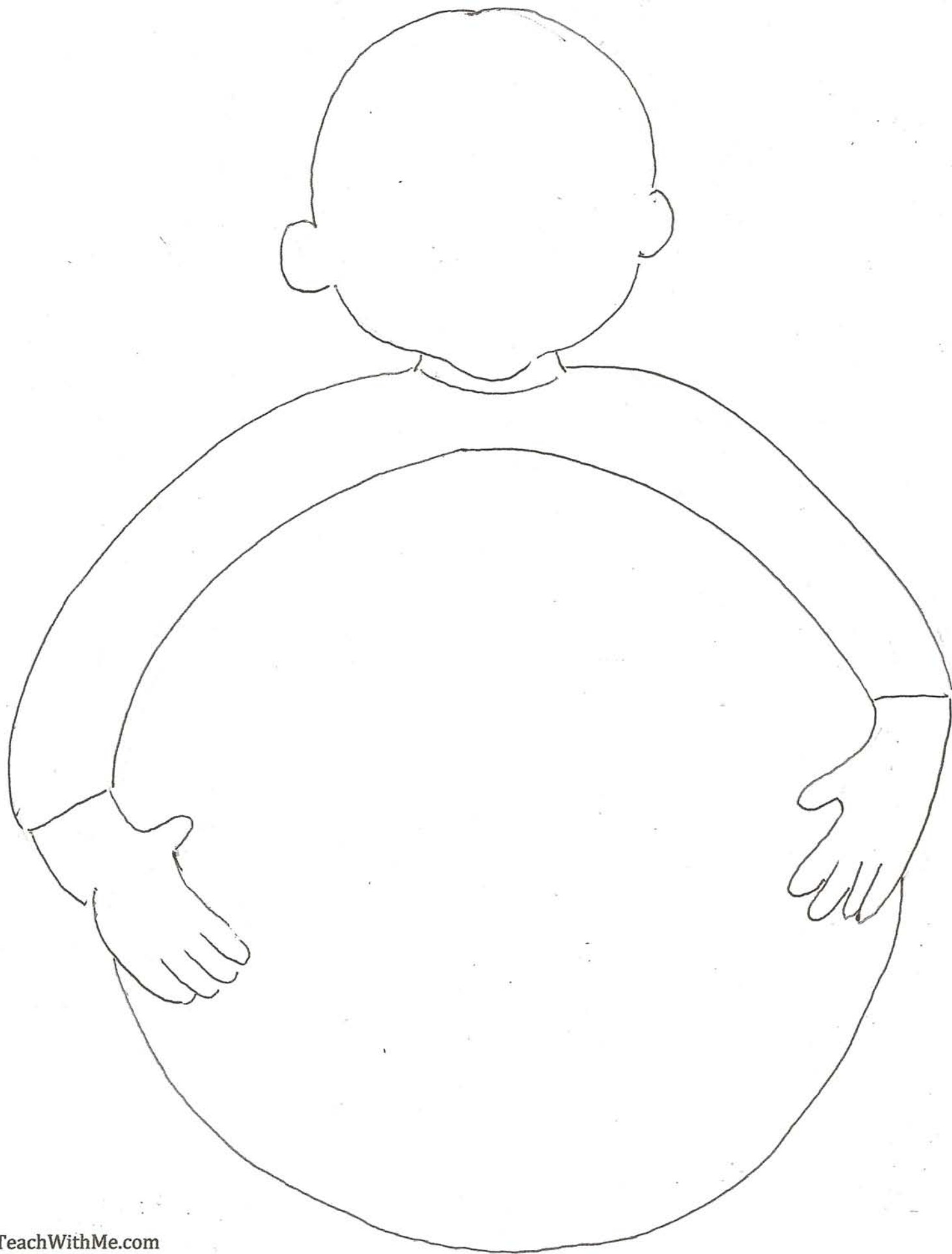
## My Thoughts On A Penny.

### Directions:

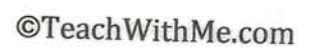
- Around the outside top of the penny, fill in the blank with your name.
