




### **Directions for Little Old Lady:**

- Print a color copy of The Little Old Lady and laminate.
- Cut her mouth out.
- Add a piece of gathered fabric at her neck if you want to. This will help hide the baggie.
- ✤ Tape a large bag under her mouth to catch the pieces.
- Run off a copy of my "Teacher's Shape Template" and trace the pieces on colored-construction paper. Make sure the shape pieces match the colors in the story. I've labeled them for you.
- ✤ I laminate the construction paper 1<sup>st</sup>. It's easier to cut out.
- I lots of shapes so that all of my students can participate in "feeding" The Little Old Lady.
- I make each shape a different color so that I can review colors in English and Spanish, so the hearts and squares I will have a variety of different colors.
- I also put the scratchy Velcro dots on 3 complete sets of shapes so that I can use them on my flannel board for identification of colors, shapes, and to pattern with as well.
- ✤ I laminate the pages of the book too.
- After I'm done with the story, I put everything, including the book in the baggie and slide The Little Old Lady in a pocket file folder.
- The children LOVE the Little Old Lady stories!
- If you wanted to, you could run off a lady for each of your students and a set of shapes so they can retell the story at home.

### **Directions for booklet:**


- Run off booklets
- Staple in the top of each corner
- Cut in half on the paper cutter
- Children WRITE their name on the cover.
- Children COLOR the shapes on the cover.
- Children TRACE the shapes & the words.
- Children COLOR or TRACE the shapes on page 9.
- I run the pizza off on brown construction paper.
- Students CUT out the pizza.
- Children COLOR, CUT and GLUE their pizza toppings to the pizza.
