Circles Of Love Coloring Pages

- I have an identical twin Kathie.
- We both were blessed by God with creativity. She's one of my cheerleaders that I call when I need to tweak something.
- We've spent many moments giggling over "I need a letter" for the alphabet books too.
- When I started the website I asked her if she had a few sketches she wanted to donate as coloring pages.
- She said she'd forage through her treasures. And Yay! She came across a plate line that was in the design stages for a company. Lucky us...so from her heart to yours we give you *Circles Of Love*.
- Here are a few things you may want to do with them after your little ones color them:
- 1. Make TWIRLERS!
 - Cut out multi-colored circles and glue one on each side.
 - Punch a hole in the top and add a bit of curling ribbon for a bow + fish line to provide an invisible twirl line.
- 2. Here's another TWIRLER.
 - Find cute patterned paper plates and glue one on the plain side.
 - Punch a hole in the top and suspend from the ceiling.
- 3. Make a PLACEMAT by gluing one in the middle of a 12x24 sheet of construction paper.
 - Then laminate.
- 4. Make a 3-D TRI-GLOBE by gluing 3 of them together.
 - Glue $\frac{1}{2}$ of one to $\frac{1}{2}$ of the other etc. 'til all of them are connected.
 - Crease them a bit.
 - Punch a hole in the top and hang from the ceiling.
- 5. Make a WREATH.
 - Mount on a green construction paper circle
 - Add glitter around the edge for a bit of pizzazz
 - Add a red bow at the top.

- 6. Make a MOBILE.
 - Glue them on a construction paper circle.
 - Glue one on the back and one on the front.
 - Dangle crepe paper, ribbon, or strips of construction paper down from the bottom.
 - Punch a hole in the top.
 - Make a yarn loop.
 - Suspend from the ceiling.
- 7. Make a CENTERPIECE square.
 - Glue 4 of them to 4 construction paper circles or squares.
 - Staple together so that they make a square.
 - Sit in the center of the table so that they can be viewed from all sides.
- 8. Make a GARLAND
 - Choose 3.
 - Punch holes in the sides.
 - Tie together with ribbon.
 - Hang from side-to-side
- 9. Make a vertical WALL HANGING
 - Choose 3.
 - Punch holes in the top and bottom.
 - Tie together with ribbon.
 - Hang from top to bottom.
- 10. Make a CARD.
 - Staple 2 sheets of construction paper together at the top or at the side, depending on how you want your card to open.
 - Choose a design and color it.
 - Glue it to the cover.
 - Write a note inside and sign it.
- 11. Handprint Keepsake GIFT
 - On the "God made little girls and boys" coloring page you could paint their hand and make a print on the other side.
 - Any other ideas?
