



Discussion, Graphing & Writing Extensions
For *Where Have All The Snowflakes Gone?*

Writing:

- Students write 5 “quick” endings of their own.
- Children share 1 or 2 of their endings with the class.

Discussion:

- Did you like the ending?
- Can you think of a better one?
- Where else could they have gone?

Math Extension:

- Teacher writes a list of the student’s ideas on the board.
- Choose three of the ideas + the book ending and **GRAPH** the favorite ending of the class.

Here are some of my new “Quick Endings”

1. Look out! They’re in that snowball headed for your head!
2. They’re part of the avalanche headed towards you right now!
3. They joined together so you could have a snow day.
4. They’re in the snowman.
5. They’re part of your snow fort.
6. They’re being whipped to and fro by the windshield wipers.
