

SHOUT It Out!

- These are number-number word flash cards, + spatial direction, shape and color flash cards so that your students can learn to read these sight words. They go along with the little booklets that the children make.
- Every time I do an Easy Reader Mystery "Where Have All The 's Gone? Or a Ten Little "Somethings" book. I flash the number cards. We say the number and read the number word together. Then I mix them up and have my students play "Shout It Out!" with me.
- I call it that because I think students like to shout because they aren't allowed to do it in school. We must use our "inside voices".
- I use the stain remover Shout's "To get a stain out, Shout it out." As a take off.
- * "To get the Stain-Pain of not being able to read out--Shout it out!" This fun little game only takes a few minutes and your students will be reading the number words in no time.
- The child who shouts out the correct number that matches the word gets the card.
- The child that shouts out the most correct answers gets a sticker, a trip to the treasure box, or whatever.
- ✤ I do the same with the spatial direction words, shapes and colors.
- Laminate the pages then cut them to the size you want.
- Simply cover the number, color, and shape with your hand when you want them to read only the word. Take your hand off, when you want them to review both. ⁽¹⁾ Enjoy!




