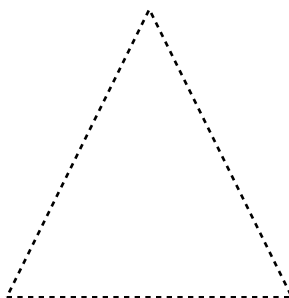
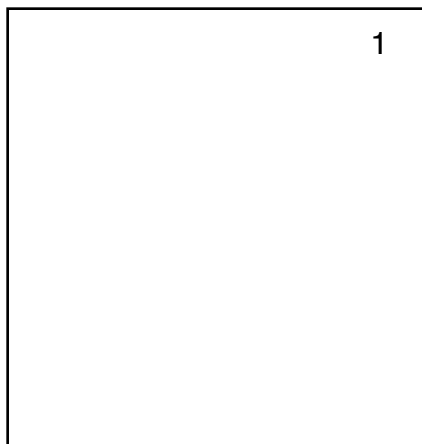




The construction worker builds a triangle roof.
