Rip and Tear Apple. Teacher cuts strips of red, yellow, brown, light and dark green construction paper. Students rip and tear the strips into pieces, making a pile of each color. Children cover the inside of their apple with a glue stick, pressing hard so that there's plenty of glue. Working quickly, students press the yellow, light green and red pieces onto their apple. When they are done, they gently lift it up and shake it a bit. Loose pieces will fall off. Students should glue them back on. After they are done with the "skin" of their apple, they do the same process for the stem and leaf.
