# Word Wall Word Activities

Your teacher will either assign you a number or let you choose one.

Do that activity with words from your word wall. Write them in your Word Wall Word Wizard notebook.

1. Choose 3 words. Write each of them down on a different line in your notebook. Next to each one write down a rhyming word.
2. Choose 3 CVC words. Write each of them down on a different line in your notebook. Next to each one write the CVC word backwards. Write an R next to the word if writing it backwards made a real word. Write an N next to it, if it is now a nonsense word. Just because you are not familiar with a word, does not mean it is not real. Make sure, by looking up the words in a dictionary, if you don't know them.
3. Choose 3 words. Write each of them down on a different line in your notebook. Next to each one write a synonym for that word. A synonym is another word, which has the same definition as that word.
4. Choose 3 words. Write each of them down on a different line in your notebook. Next to each one write an antonym for that word. An antonym is another word, which has the opposite meaning as that word.
5. Choose 2 four letter words and define them.
6. List a noun, verb and adjective. Define them and state what part of speech they are. i.e sunshine:  
Light from the sun. Noun
7. Write all of your color words in their matching colors and put them in alphabetical order.
8. Write all of your number words and put the numeric number next to them.
9. Write all of your number words and put them in alphabetical order.
10. Write all of your shape words and put them in alphabetical order.
11. Write all of your month words and put them in chronological order.
12. Write all of your month words and put them in alphabetical order.
13. Write all of your days of the week words and put them in chronological order.
14. Write all of your days of the week words and put them in alphabetical order.

14. Write down 5 words that have the same beginning SOUND.
15. Write down 5 words that have the same ending SOUND.
16. Write down 3 words that have a short vowel sound.
17. Write down 3 words that have a long vowel sound.
18. Write down 5 words that begin with a letter from the beginning of the alphabet ( a-h )
19. Write down 5 words that begin with a letter from the middle of the alphabet ( i-q )
20. Write down 5 words that begin with a letter from the end of the alphabet ( r-z )
21. Write down 5 words in alphabetical order.
22. Look at the word wall. Write down the shortest word and the longest word. Count how many letters are in each one and add them together. What is the total amount of all of the letters?
23. Write down the plural of 5 words.
24. Write down 3 words that you can add an -ing ending to and still have a real word.
25. Find 3 words that you can think of an opposite for and write them down with the opposite word next to it. i.e, stop go
26. Choose 3 words and write them in your favorite color marker or crayon.
27. Choose 3 words and write them in your least favorite color marker or crayon.
28. Choose 3 words that are at least 4 letters long. Write them on separate lines. Next to the word, write the word backwards. Define your new nonsense word.
29. Choose 3 words and define them. Now look them up in a dictionary and write down the dictionary's definition. Were your definitions the same? Did you learn anything new about your word(s)?
30. Choose 3 words and write them in ink pen and then trace over them with a yellow highlighter.

31. Think of a letter, and look for a word that you can make into different words by adding a letter 4 times. i.e. b, bi, bit, bite, bites
32. Make a list of 5 words. The first word should be 2 letters long, the 2nd, 3 letters long; the 3rd, 5 letters long; and the 5th, 6 letters long.
33. Choose 3 of your favorite words. Write them on 3 different lines. Explain why you like these words.
34. Write down 5 words on 5 different lines. CIRCLE all of the vowels and UNDERLINE all of the consonants.
35. Write down a word with a short a sound and another word with a long a sound.
36. Write down a word with a short e sound and another word with a long e sound.
37. Write down a word with a short i sound and another word with a long i sound.
38. Write down a word with a short o sound and another word with a long o sound.
39. Write down a word with a short u sound and another word with a long u sound.
40. Write down 2 words that have at least 2 letters that are also in your first name. Underline the letters that are in both.
41. Write down 2 words that have at least 2 letters that are also in your last name. Underline the letters that are in both.
42. Write down 2 words that don't have any letters in them that are in your first name.
43. Write down 2 words that don't have any letters in them that are in your last name.
44. Write down 3 words that begin with the same letter as the first letter of your name.
45. Write down 3 words that begin with the same letter as the first letter of your last name.
46. Write down 3 words that end with the same letter as the first letter of your name.

31. Write down 3 words that end with the same letter as the first letter of your last name.
32. Write down 3 words that end with the same letter that your first name ends with.
33. Write down 3 words that end with the same letter that your last name ends with.
34. Write down 3 family words. i.e. brother, mother, father, etc.
35. Write down 3 calendar words. i.e. days of the week, months, etc.
36. Write down 3 weather words and alphabetize them.
37. Write down 3 winter words and alphabetize them.
38. Write down 3 spring words and alphabetize them.
39. Write down 3 summer words and alphabetize them.
40. Write down 3 fall words and alphabetize them.
41. Look at the words. Choose 4 that you can make into 2 compound words. i.e. cup and cake = cupcake  
write them down as I have.
42. Choose a word, write it down and illustrate it.
43. Find 2 words that have the same amount of letters as your first name. Write them down.
44. Draw a picture of a person. Label the body parts that are on your word wall. i.e. head, arms, legs, etc.
45. Choose 2 words and do something with them. Write down an explanation of what you did.
46. Choose 3 words and write them in large print so that they take up 2 lines of width.
47. Choose 3 words and write them as tiny as you can print.
48. Flip your notebook upside down. Write 3 words on 3 different lines so that when you flip your book  
right-side up, the words will appear upside down.
49. Write 3 words as fast as you can.
50. Write 2 words on a sheet of scratch paper. Cut out each letter and glue the word together into  
your notebook.
51. Choose a 5 letter word. Write as many words as you can think of, using those 5 letters.
