Play in groups of 2-4. Take turns rolling the dice. Add the dice together. Whatever number you get, color that portion of the picture labeled with that number. The 1st player to completely color their picture, or the one with most of their picture colored in, before the timer rings, is the winner. If your teacher wants you to, write the equations on the back of your paper, of how you added the dice together to get that sum. If you want play to last longer, you can require students roll an 8, 9, 10, and 11 TWICE. The 1st time they color the pilgrims' clothes; the 2nd time they color the hair and body parts.
