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# **Turkey Twirlers**

#### **Materials:**

- Brown, red, yellow, orange construction paper
- Black pen or crayon
- Glue sticks
- Paper cutter
- Crayons
- Hole punch and a bit of yarn if you want to hang from the ceiling.

#### **Directions:**

## Prep:

- Run off turkey master on brown construction paper
- Pre-cut 1 inch wide strips of red, yellow and orange construction paper

### The next day...

- 1. Children add some color to their turkey with the crayons.
- 2. Students WRITE their name on the bottom of the turkey by the word Love,
- 3. Children TWIRL a strip of red paper around a crayon and then glue the end of it to the first feather. What a fun fine motor skill!
- 4. They do the same with an orange and then a yellow strip for the 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> feathers and then repeat the red-orange-yellow pattern for the 4<sup>th</sup> 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> feathers.
- 5. These look great with a hole punched in the middle of the top and hung back-to-back from the ceiling with a yarn loop.
- 6. My students enjoy making them so much they are too excited about their artwork and want to take their turkeys home.
