

Print, laminate and trim.

Print, laminate and trim.

Using a dry erase marker write a 3-digit number in the triangle portion of the house. Students break the number down to show its place value and write their answer on their gingerbread house-recording mat. When they hold up their answer, you show yours. Is theirs correct? This is a quick and easy way to whole-group assess.



Print on white construction paper; laminate and trim. Using red and green dry erase markers, students break down numbers that are called. When they have recorded the place value of the number, they hold up their house. You can also run off copies for your students to color. To turn them into dry erase boards, have students glue squares of glossy photo paper in the windows.
