


Run off on white construction paper.

I had my husband press his thumb onto a bronze stamp pad and then press his inked thumb onto a sheet of beige construction paper. I then pressed my thumb next to his to make a heart shape.

I cut it out and glued it to a circle of embossed scrapbook paper, and then put it under a glass paper weight. The paper weights were only a dollar at Michael's Craft Store.

This would be a great keepsake for Valentine's Day or Mother's Day.

You could also make a magnet, and use the large flat-backed clear glass rocks that they sell by the bag at floral and hobby stores for just a \$1.99 for 20+ stones.

The heart thumb print is not my original idea. I've seen it pinned numerous times on wedding boards, but thought I'd design something for children.
