

Run off on card stock. Your current students color the bookmark and write a note to a new student who will be in your class in the fall. To make this even more special have them include a photo of themselves.




Run off on white construction paper. Students trim and glue to the top of their cupcake liner.

This is the portion that they will complete the writing prompt on.

The other topper that is printed with your grade level, will be trimmed and "hinged" to the side of this one, so that when you flip the top section over, it will reveal the writing underneath.

Run off on a variety of colors of construction or scrapbook paper. I put mine through a crinkle roller to make it look more like a cupcake liner. Students trim and glue the blank cupcake topper to the top of the "liner." (They will write on this) and hinge (Use Scotch tape) the "______ was really sweet" topper.
