


The Cat's Hat: Games & Activities Telling Time To The Hour & Half Hour

•If you'd like to add a bit of color to your cards, trace around the hat with a red marker, or run the clock hats off on red construction paper.


I thought it would add some pizzazz to make the tip of my clothespin look like the cat's hat. I simply trimmed a white address label, stuck it on the end and drew in some red stripes with a marker.
Print, laminate & trim your cards.

•Toss them in a Seuss hat or other container with some clothespins.

•Pinching clothespins is an excellent fine motor skill that will strengthen finger muscles.

•To make this center game self-checking, put a dot on the back of the card. In the photo above, the dot would be located on the back where the 5:00 box is. Children flip over the card to see if their clothespin is on the dot.
