# Glyphs





## Prep for the bunny glyph:

- If you like the idea of adding a cotton ball to the back for a bunny tail, you can get a bag at The Dollar Store. To save time & mess, I give my kiddos a glue dot to fasten it with.



- Run off the bunny patterns on white construction paper.
- Run off the bow patterns on a variety of pastel (springtime) colors.
- Rough cut the ears, arms, feet & bows.
- Each child gets 2 of each body part, plus a bow color of their choice.
- Children trim the pieces but do NOT glue them to their bunny.
- Students will need a glue stick and crayons or markers.
- Tell them to listen to all of the directions before they do anything to

their bunny.

- I have capitalized important directional words so that you can easily emphasize them.
- Slowly read the directions, with special emphasis on the capitalized words.
- If children would like ONE repeat, they may raise their hand.
- I've included a labeled bunny poster for clarification.
- Afterwards, allow time for students to share their bunnies.
- My students always enjoy seeing my sample.
- Completed projects make a sweet bulletin board.

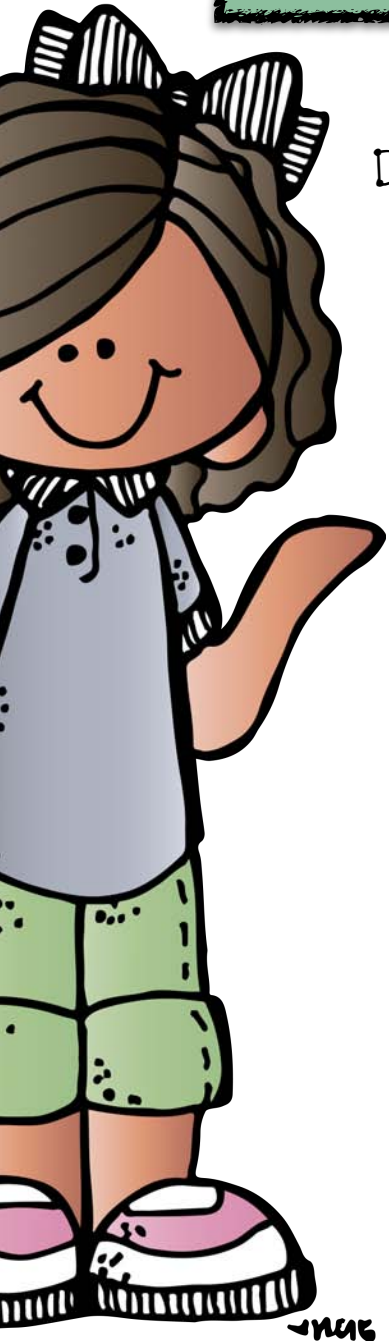
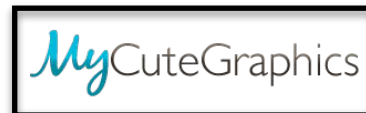
