These are all of the story cards. Pass them out to your students before reading *The Very Hungry Caterpillar*, when you come to a section in the story featuring that card, pause and have the child holding that card "feed" it to the caterpillar. Afterwards, check comprehension by using the cards to retell the story as a whole group.



Alpha-pillar alphabet cards. Besides "feeding" the caterpillar, students can play Memory Match games, matching an uppercase letter to a lowercase letter. They can also play "Speed Sequence" to see who can be the first to put the cards in alphabetical order. You can also mix up the 3 sets and they can sort them. Play "I Have; Who Has?" as a whole group.





Ordinal number practice. Sequence the food that the hungry caterpillar ate.



Besides feeding the caterpillar, children can play Memory Match, matching number to number or number to number word. They can also play "Speed Sequence" against a partner, use the math symbols to make equations, and play "I Have; Who Has?" games as a whole group.



There are clocks to the hour, plus clocks to the half hour, as well as a blank set of clocks so you can program with other times.

Days of the week cards featuring the food that the caterpillar ate on that day.



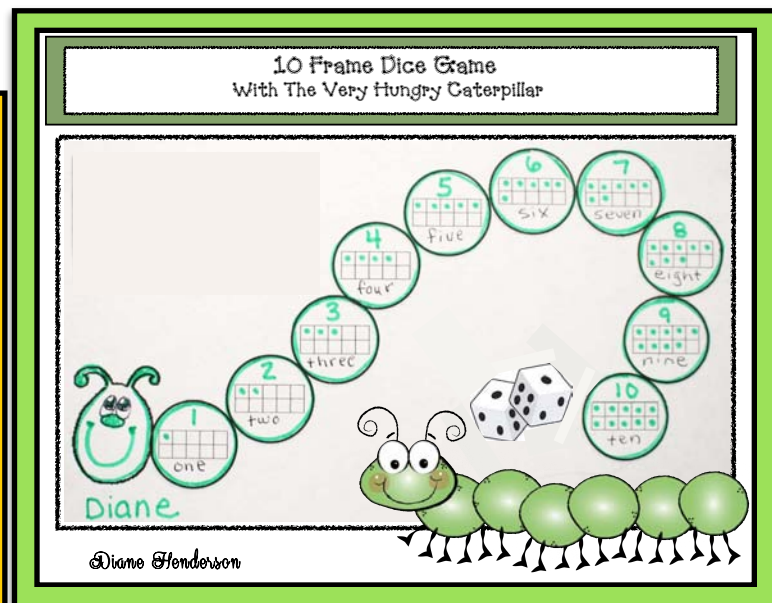
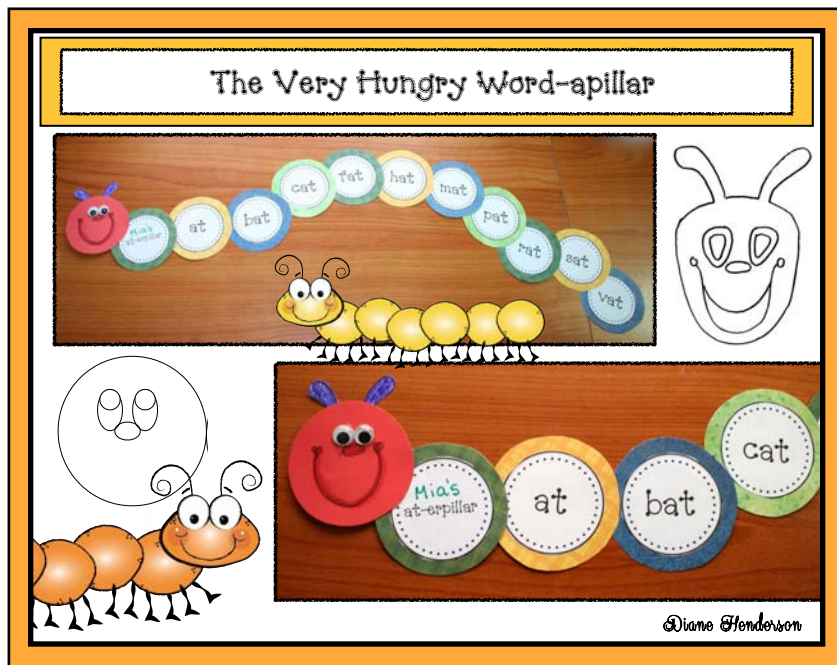
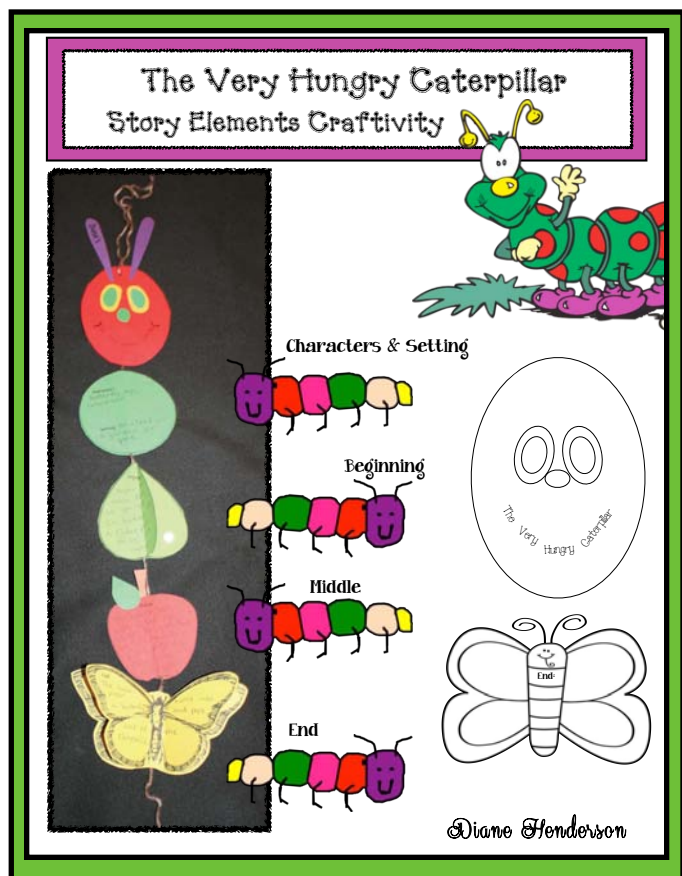
