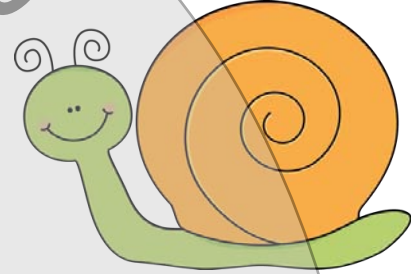
There are lots of options to choose from. Each label comes in black & white as well as color, for both the acronyms.
