






CVC Shamrock Shape Up-Vowel Howl With A Leprechaun


- Make a template out of a file folder.
- Trace the shamrock on 3 different shades of green construction paper.
- Write the appropriate letters on the various colors.
- Laminate and then cut out a class set of vowel shamrocks on lime green,
- letter l shamrocks on dark green,
- and consonants b,d,g,m,p,t,w,x,y on emerald green.
- Write those letters on the 3 different color construction paper shamrocks
- or run off my templates, laminate and cut them out.
- Students make a list of CVC words starting with the letter l,
- using all of the vowels and those consonants
- and then use the shamrocks to make the words.
- When students complete a word let them "howl" it out or say *woo who, yippee* or some other little leprechaun thing that you can think of.
- Play some Irish music while students work.





