(Don't break my heart by not knowing your alphabet!)

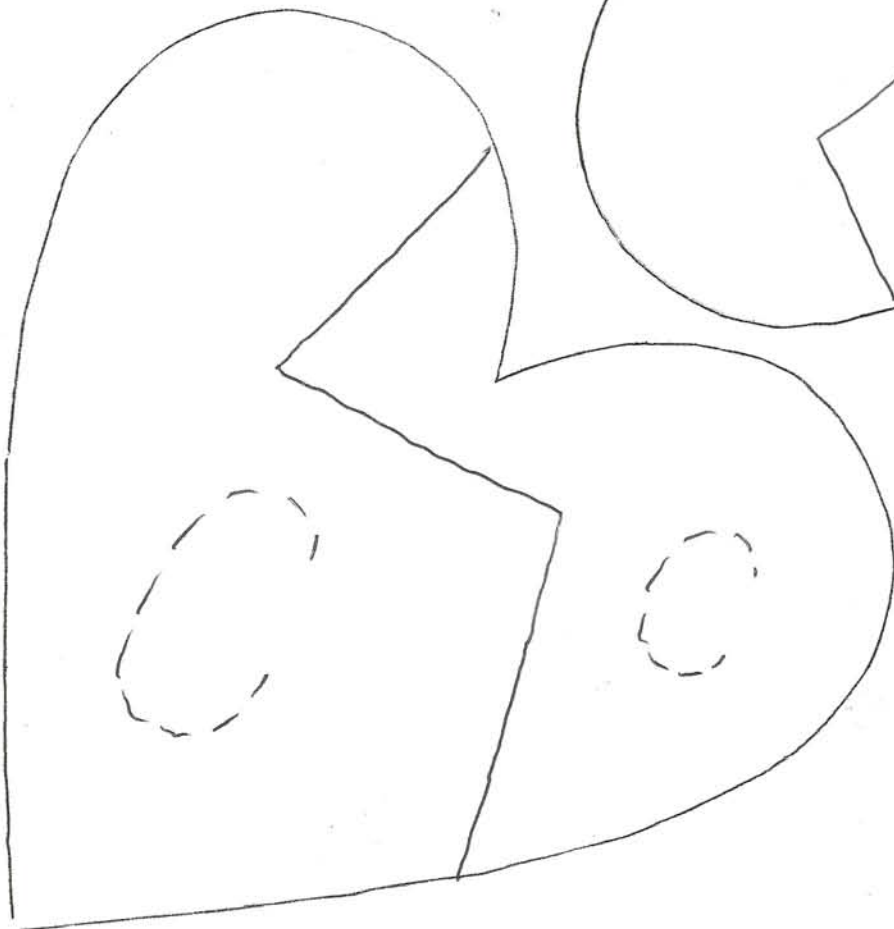
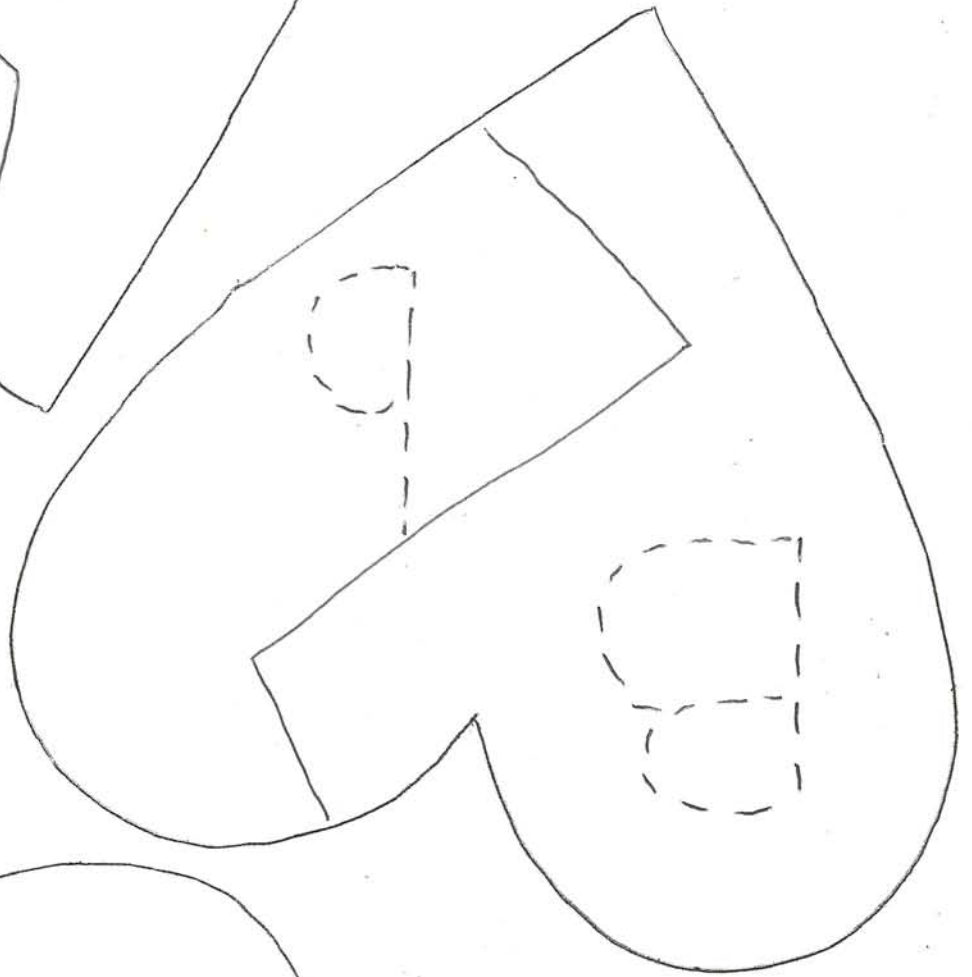
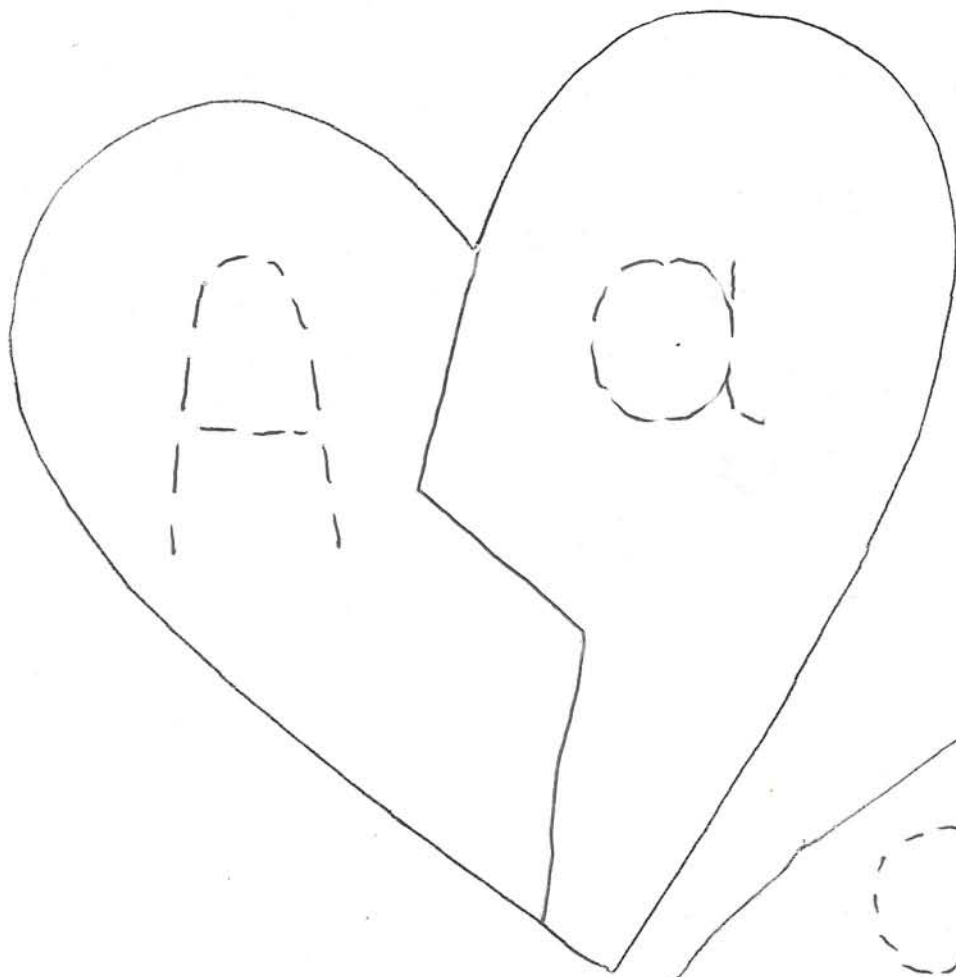

Materials:

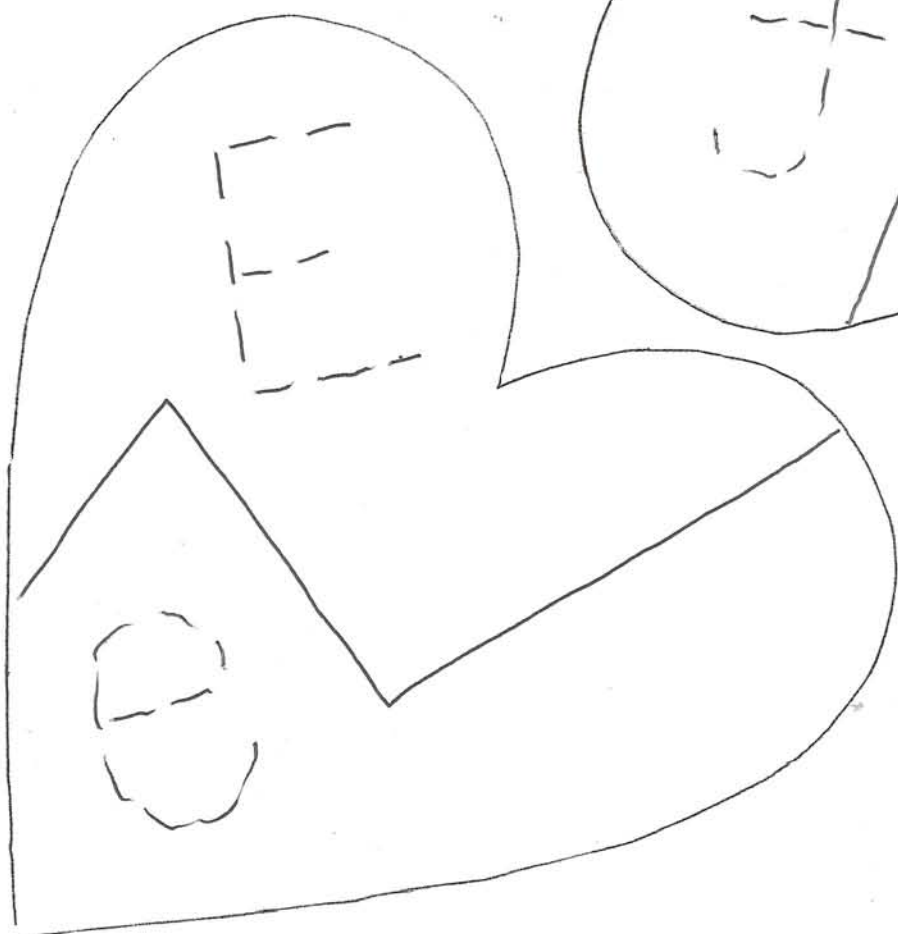
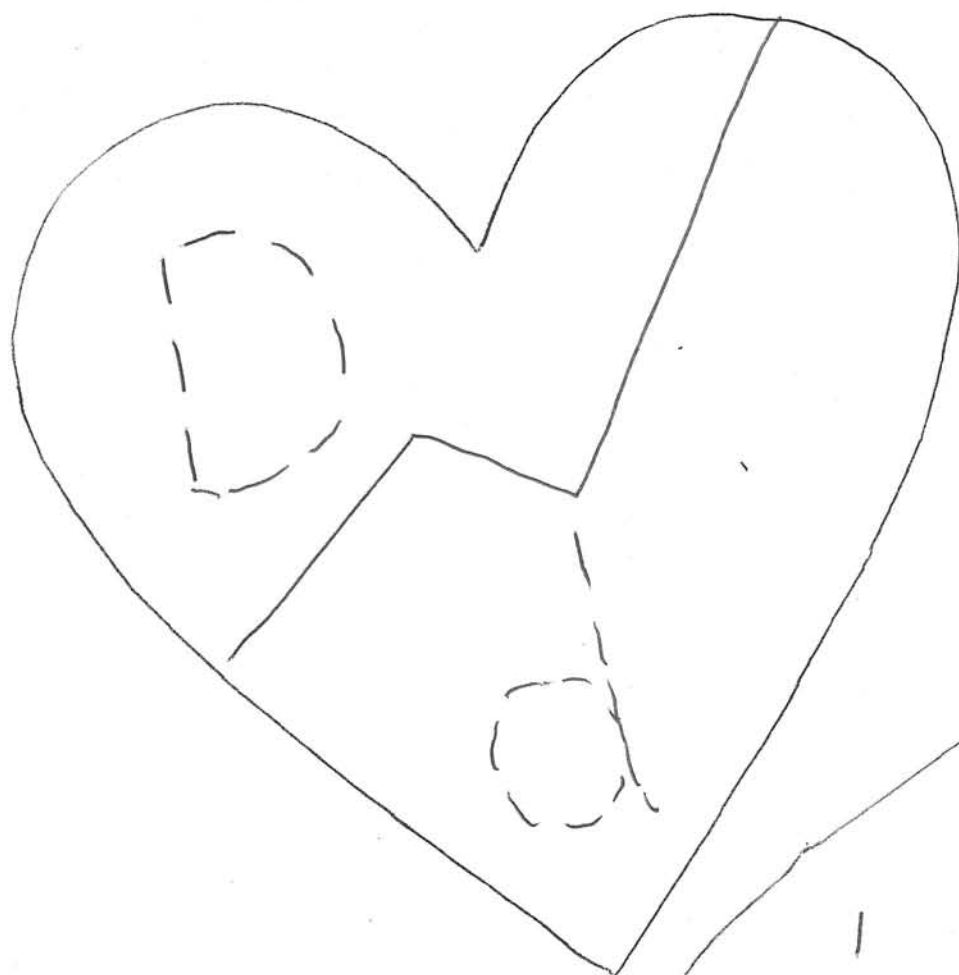
- Red construction paper
- Scissors
- Markers

Directions:

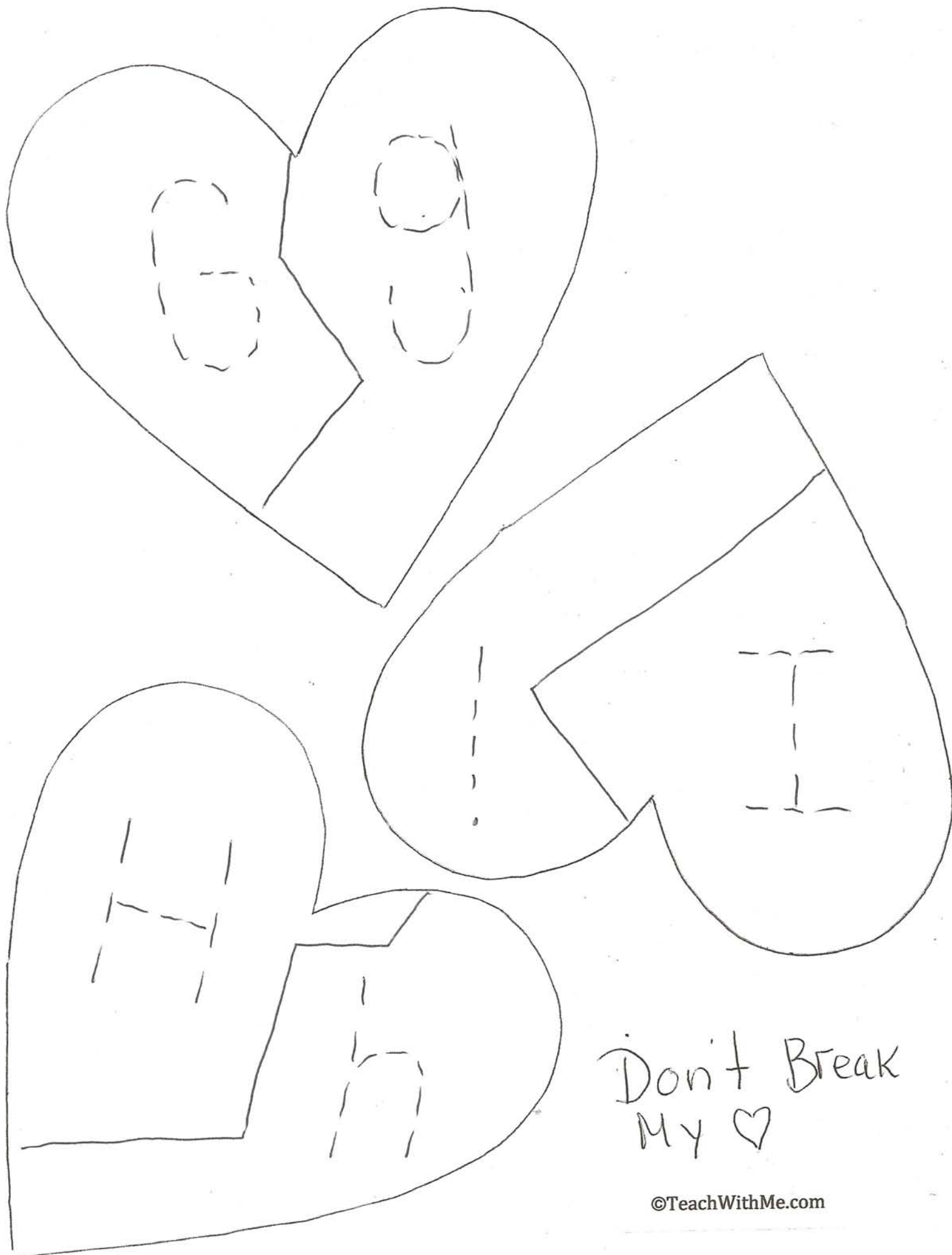
- Run off the masters on construction paper, laminate and cut out.
- Sprinkle a matching number on the floor to the number of children you have in class.
- Students pick up a "broken heart" and find their upper or lower case match to mend their heart.
- You can also pass around a basket or bag of hearts and partner up children this way for a game or lesson.
- You can also ***play "I Have, Who Has"*** where teacher says, "I have an uppercase **A**. Who has the lowercase **a**?" Play continues 'til you have mended all of the broken hearts.
- You can also run off sets on colored copy paper to send home with struggling students.
- Have them **TRACE** the letters, cut out their hearts and play at home to reinforce letter recognition in a fun way.



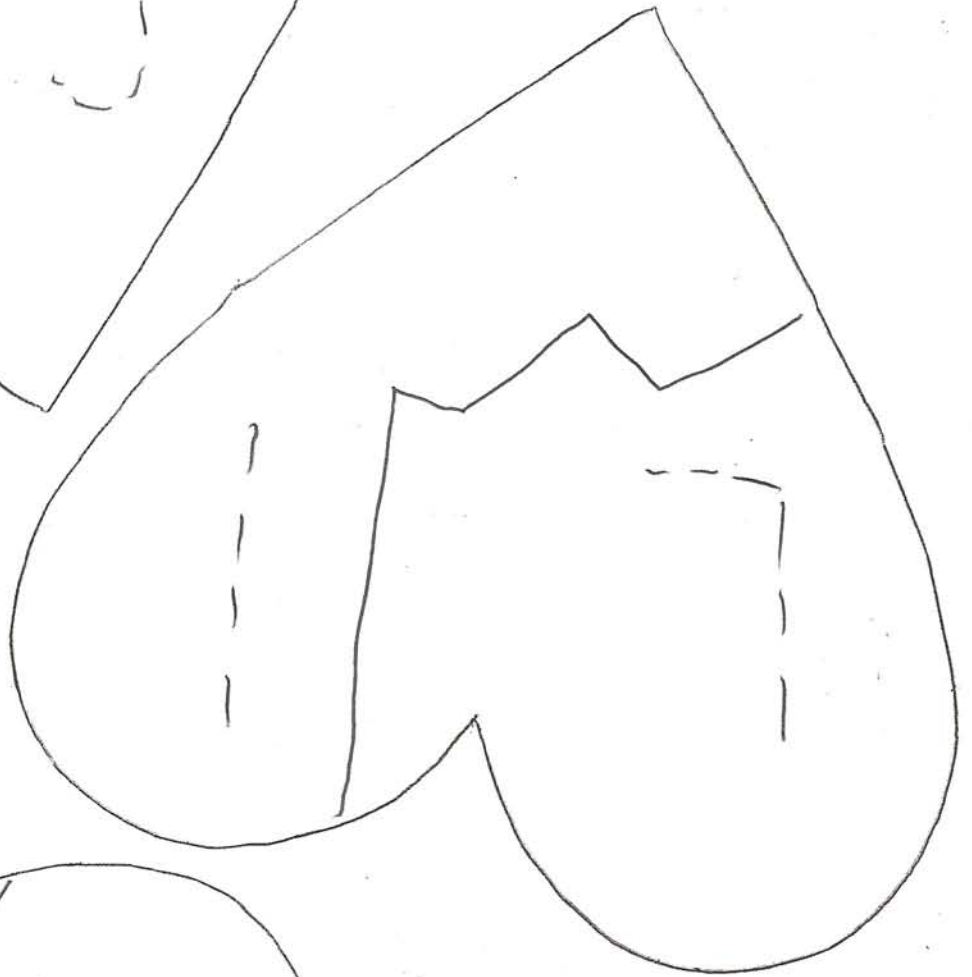
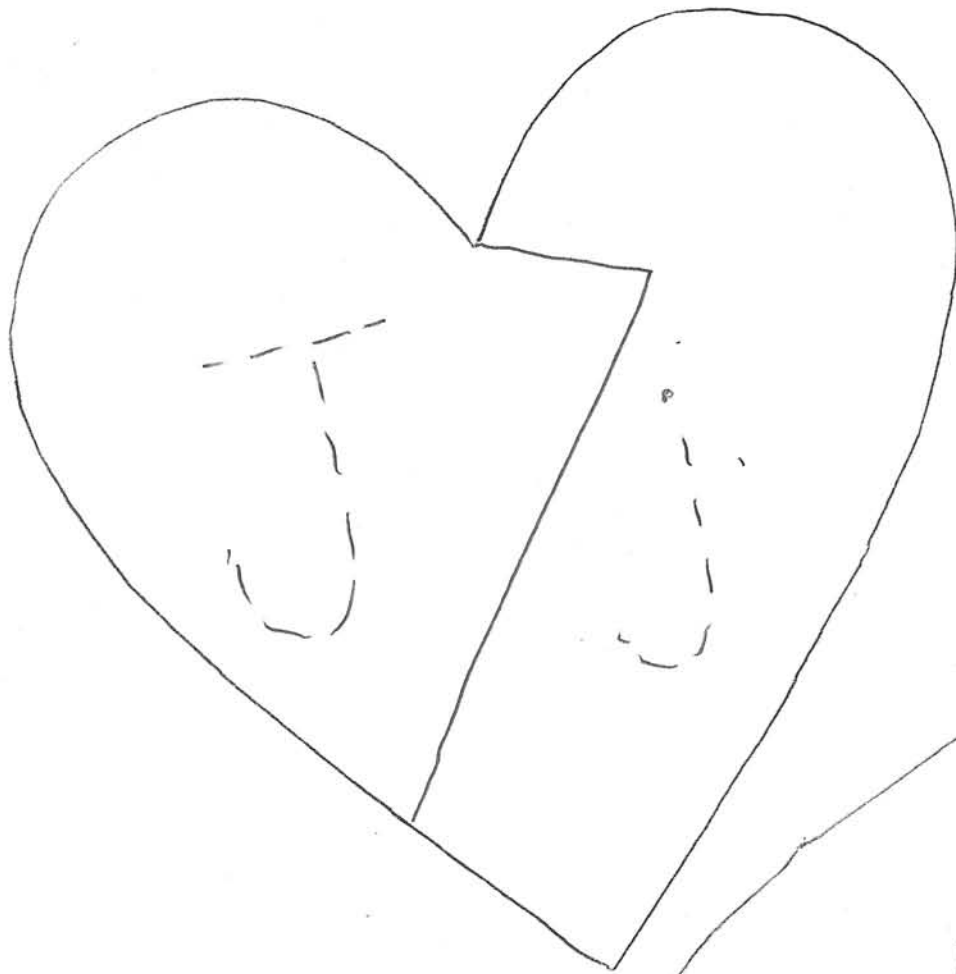
