These little counting books give you lots of “bang for your time!”

- Students READ the number as a number and as a word.
- Students trace the number and word.
- They write the number and word.
- They read and see that many of “something” in a sentence.
- They spy that number in a sequence of numbers and CIRCLE that number.
- They X that many boxes. Students can also bingo dot or stamp that many boxes.
- Students cut and glue the group/set to the matching numbered boxes.
- When everyone has finished their booklet, read it aloud as a whole group and review concepts of print.
- Children will be able to take these booklets home and share them with their families.
- These are great self-esteem builders.
- You can do a page a day or an entire booklet.
- Children only need to do one of these booklets with assistance and then be able to do them independently; a different one each week or month according to your needs and themes.
- It’s a great way to learn how to identify and read numbers and number words and cover a variety of skills and standards!

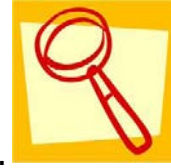
