
# Seasons Rebus Reader

snowflake = winter, flower = spring, sun = summer, leaves = fall







## **4** Seasons Mobile

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## Materials:

- Red, blue yellow, orange, and pink construction paper
- Circles = snowflake on blue, daisy on pink, sun on yellow, leaf on orange, heart is red.
- White copy paper
- Watercolor markers
- Dental floss, white yarn or string
- Scissors
- Glue sticks
- **Optional:** Scotch tape

## **Directions:**

### Prep:

- Run off masters.
- Make templates and have students or room helper trace them.
- Make copies of students' class picture and cut them out.

#### The next day...

- Children cut out their circles and hearts.
- Using markers, students color the leaf and borders on the pieces.
- Students write what their favorite season is and underneath write WHY.
- Children glue this white heart to the larger red one.
- Students glue their photo above the "My favorite …" sentence on the white heart. It will likely go over the edge onto the red heart.
- Children glue the seasonal pictures to the colored circles.
- Students either raise their hand, or bring their work to the teacher who will help them lay their pieces in a vertical line with about a finger's width between them.
- Lay yarn/string down the center of each piece. I tape the string down in the middle of each piece so that it doesn't move.
- Students completely cover their heart and word circles with glue and press them on top of the yarn/string.
- Hang with a paperclip from the ceiling for a great dangling display that twirls beautifully.
