Each time they read the story-poem to you, please draw a star or smile face in the box. When they have filled in all of the boxes, please sign the bottom of the paper and return it to school.


As an incentive, and self-esteem builder, I keep track of who returns their paper on a class poster. Students receive a sticker by their name; so many stickers equals a prize.


