

Free Life-Cycle Of A Frog Activities



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Frog Life Cycle Slider

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Materials:

- Green and white construction paper
- Scissors
- Pink or red crayons
- Black ink pen
- ***Optional:*** wiggle eyes, heart stickers, plastic flies, glue dots for wiggle eyes/fly

Directions:

Prep:

- Run off the frogs on green construction paper.
- Run off the life cycle strips on white construction paper.
- Cut the strips on a paper cutter.
- Cut slider-slits in the frogs.

The next day...

1. Students CUT out their frog.
2. Children either COLOR the heart cheeks or add 2 heart stickers.
3. Students add a smile to their frog with a red or pink crayon and color the tongue as well.
4. Students color the eyes or glue on wiggle eyes. Can also glue on a plastic fly to the tongue using a glue dot.
5. Children poke their strip under the frog and through the slit and then down through the other slit. Younger children may have trouble with this. Make sure you model this. REMIND students to have their strip facing UP and to check to make sure their strip is NOT upside down.
6. Using an ink pen, students WRITE their name under the slider, on the leg of the frog.
7. When everyone has finished their frog, review the life cycle by having children pull their strip through the frog to the appropriate stage.

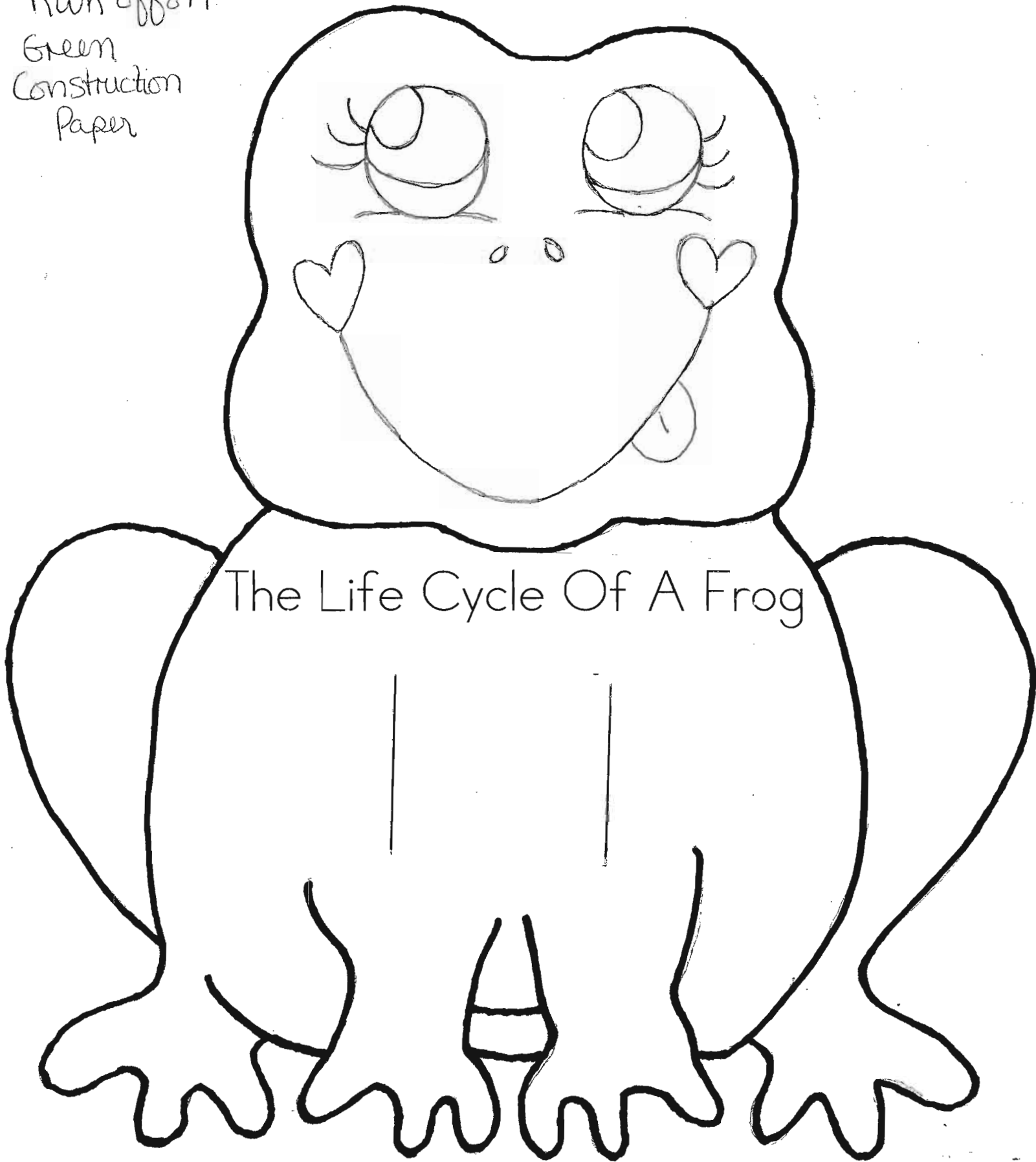

Life Cycle of a Frog Slider Strips



Frog life cycle crowns.

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Materials:

- Green construction paper
- White copy paper
- Crayons
- Scissors
- Glue sticks
- Stapler

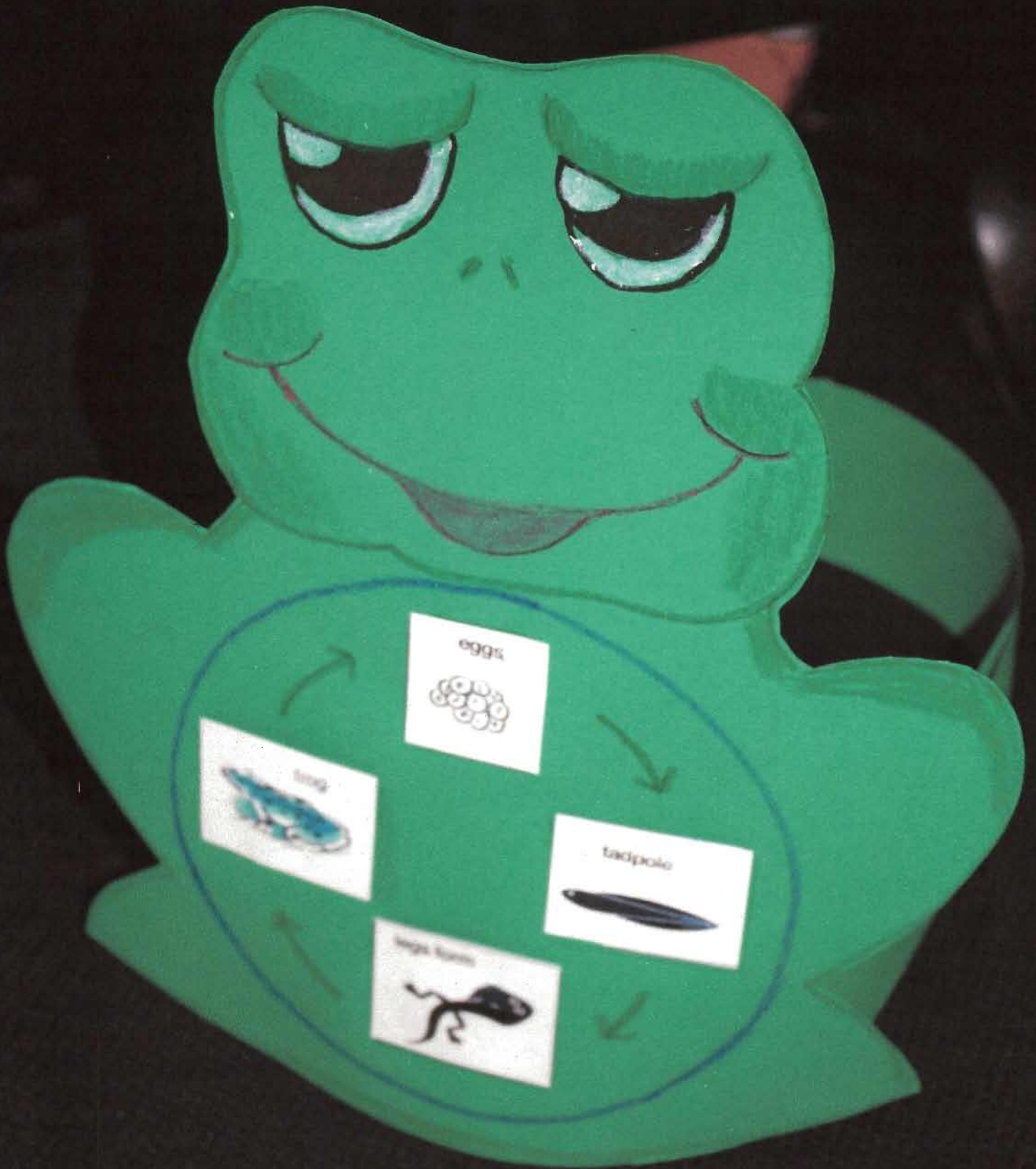
Directions:

Prep:

- Run off masters.
- Cut out sections of life-cycle so that each student has one.

The next day...

- Children CUT out their frog.
- Students ADD detail using a crayon.
- Children CUT out their life-cycle parts and GLUE them to the correct boxes of the frog's circular tummy.
- Teacher staples green strips to either side of the frog and makes a crown for each child OR simply hang in the hallway or mount on a lily pad.
- To get the wiggles out, you can have students line up and see who can hop the farthest in one jump, or jump up and down and all around counting by 1's, 2's, 3's 5's or 10's. You could also "blast off" and count from 10 to 0.
