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## Scarecrow What Do You See?

### Materials:

- Tan, yellow, brown, green & blue construction paper
- Crayons
- Scissors
- Glue sticks
- Optional: Buttons & Glue Dots

### Directions:

#### Prep:

- Run off masters
- I Pre-cut all of the pieces except the jeans, coat & book. I feel that is enough cutting.
- Cut 2 x 2 inch strips of yellow so the children can make hay "stuffing" and hair.
- I set this up as a center and have all the other pre-cut pieces in little rectangular baskets on a table along with the rough-cut coat and jeans + a tub of scissors and glue sticks.

#### The next day...

1. I show the children how to glue a strip of yellow on the back of the sleeve and hem of the pants and then just snip chunks away so that it looks like hay stuffing. I also show them how to take another strip and do that, then glue it to the side, top, and under the bottom of the scarecrow's face so it looks like hair. (See photo, & display your sample.)
2. Children CUT out their green coat and blue jeans.
3. Students GLUE the jeans to the BACK of the coat.
4. Children get their other pieces.
5. Students GLUE a yellow strip to the BACK of each sleeve and make snips in it.
6. Children GLUE a yellow strip to the BACK of each pant leg and make snips in it.
7. Students WRITE their name with a black crayon on the top of the blue jeans, just under the green coat.
8. Children COLOR the face of the scarecrow.
9. Students GLUE 2 yellow strips on the back of the bottom of the scarecrow's face. This is the "neck" area. Children make snips in it.
10. Children GLUE the face on top of the green coat.
11. Children snip some more yellow strips to make hair for their scarecrow and glue it on the sides of the face as well as the top of the head so it looks like hangs.
12. Students glue the hat on top of the scarecrow's head so that it over laps the hair.
13. Children CUT their book and SEQUENCE it, putting the green cover on the top.
14. Students raise their hand to get it stapled and then GLUE it to the middle of their scarecrow's tummy. I have them add two buttons down the front.
15. Children TRACE the color words.
16. When everyone is done, read the book together.
17. We do the *Scarecrow Pokey* with our books before we take them to our lockers.


Green pine what do you see?




